- c) The positive commandment: Bring them up: feed, nourish, train up to maturity.
- The overarching goal: bring your children to maturity. Now, what is maturity for Paul? Ephessians 4:13 to become like Christ.
- <u>The means</u>: the <u>discipline</u> and <u>instruction</u> of the Lord One word implies the chastening (or discipline)

The other word refers to the exhortation or rebuke addressed to the mind.

CONCLUSION: This is just not a good counsel to have a nice family life

- The passages are imperatives.
- 2. Rest now / toil later.

Toil now and your children will bring you rest Pr 22:6, Train up a child in **the way he should go**, Even when **he** is old **he** will not depart from it. Comp Pr 10:1 & 15:26

3. Perhaps some of us need to confess and repent before our children, for having provoked them to anger and to lose heart

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

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The Priority of the Glory of God #14 In our family life (5)

Introduction: Those who are the closest to us are the ones who can irritate and frustrate us the most.

REVIEW:

I - The place of the family in God's purposes to Glorify Himself

II - The Man in a God-Glorifying home

III - The Woman of a God-Glorifying home

IV - The Children in a home whose priority is the Glory of God

V – The <u>Parents</u> whose priority is the Glory of God Eph 6:4

My rendering: And fathers, do not <u>bring anger side by side to</u> your children, but feed them to maturity in the discipline / chastening and exhortation of the Lord

a) <u>The addressees - Fathers</u>: Paul does not see fathers <u>just as providers</u>.
 The weight of the commandment is placed on them

One commentary writes: "fathers--including mothers; the fathers are specified as being the fountains of domestic authority. Fathers are more prone to passion in relation to their children than mothers, whose fault is rather over-indulgence."

Pr 6:20-23

- b) The first commandment is negative: Do not provoke to anger: Parogidzo (To bring anger to the side). Example/illustration: parakletos
- Parents: this is not about you...
- What is it to "provoke a child to anger"?

<u>The parallel text</u>: Colossians 3:21 "Fathers, do not <u>exasperate</u> your children, <u>that they may not lose heart</u>."

The distillation of the meaning: $\alpha\theta\nu\mu\dot{\epsilon}\omega$ a + thumos = No + Anger or passion, meaning to be dispirited, or to become disheartened and broken in your spirit.

Bible illustrations of parents "provoking" their children

1. Showing partiality or playing favorites

- **Isaac & Rebecah**: "mom" showed favoritism to Jacob because he was a sweet home boy / "dad" showed favoritism to Esau because he was a rough and manly hunter.
- Sadly, Jacob did the same...

Practical: if you have more than one child make of each child a favorite

2. Unfaithfulness & Disobedience

Numbers 13 & 14.

Nm 14:31-33 'Your children, however ...and they shall suffer *for* your <u>unfaithfulness</u>, until your corpses lie in the wilderness.

Practical: Counsel to single ladies...
