QUESTION # 114: WHAT REASONS ARE ANNEXED TO THE THIRD COMMANDMENT?

ANSWER:

THE REASONS ANNEXED TO THE THIRD COMMANDMENT, IN THESE WORDS, [THE LORD THY GOD,] AND, [FOR THE LORD WILL NOT HOLD HIM GUILTY THAT TAKETH HIS NAME IN VAIN,^A] ARE, BECAUSE HE IS THE LORD AND OUR GOD, THEREFORE HIS NAME IS NOT TO BE PROFANED, OR ANY WAY ABUSED BY US;^B ESPECIALLY BECAUSE HE WILL BE SO FAR FROM ACQUITTING AND SPARING THE TRANSGRESSORS OF THIS COMMANDMENT, AS THAT HE WILL NOT SUFFER THEM TO ESCAPE HIS RIGHTEOUS JUDGMENT,^C ALBEIT MANY SUCH ESCAPE THE CENSURES AND PUNISHMENTS OF MEN.^D
