Responsive Reading

Leader: Which is the ninth commandment?

People: The ninth commandment is, Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

Leader: What is required in the ninth commandment?

People: The ninth commandment requires the maintaining and promoting of truth between man and man, and of our own and our neighbor's good name, especially in witness bearing.

Leader: What is forbidden in the ninth commandment?

People: The ninth commandment forbids whatsoever is prejudicial to truth, or injurious to our own, or our neighbor's, good name. (Shorter Catechism 76-78)

Corporate Confession of Sin

Leader: God of Truth and Righteousness, against you, and you only, we have sinned and wandered from your ways.

People: We confess that we have borne false witness and been untrue and unfaithful toward our neighbor, that we have shaded, twisted, and denied the truth.

Leader: We are gossips, tale tellers, and liars.

People: O LORD our Lord, have mercy upon us.

All: Teach us to hate our errors, cleanse us from our secret faults, and forgive our sins for the sake of your Son.
