Do Not Harden Your Heart

An exposition and application of Psalm 95:7-11 Hebrews 3:7-19

Introduction: The frightening reality of hearing the preached Word Possible responses: 1) Run away; 2) Hardening; 3) Repentance

Exposition: This text is an exposition of Psalm 95, with application

The original context in Numbers chapters 13 & 14

The application to the author's audience (including us)

Watch out brothers (v. 12)

Exhort one another every day (v. 13)

A genuine warning against apostasy (v. 14)

Be concerned with being faithful today (v. 15)

Who is it that rebelled? (v. 16-17)

The destiny of the disobedient (v. 18)

The base reason for their disobedience – unbelief (v. 19)

They failed to believe the gospel (Ex 6:6-8, Ps 106)

Application: Are you rebellious? Don't harden your heart!
