## **Being Good and Working Hard**

Ecclesiastes 2:12-26

- I. **BEING GOOD** (12-17)—enlightened, righteous, and prudent
  - **A.** Enlightened Life (12-14)—studied, considered, intentional
  - B. <u>Prudent</u> Life—smart, careful, practical responsibility
  - **C.** Righteous Life—upright, honorable, moral responsibility
  - **D.** Mortal Life (14b-17)—personal death and cultural amnesia
    - 1. Wisdom won't keep you from dying.
    - 2. There is no future reward.
    - 3. Your wisdom and accomplishments won't last.
- II. WORKING HARD (10b, 18-23)—why we do
  - A. The gift of work is a blessing. (Gen 2).
    - 1. God works.
    - 2. God designed humans to work.
  - **B.** The frustration of work is a curse. (Gen 3)
    - 1. Being unable to work is devastating.
    - 2. <u>Working for someone else</u> for something you don't care about can be drudgery.
    - 3. <u>Working for yourself</u> toward a goal you believe in is meaningful and exhilarating.
  - C. Death is the ultimate frustration of work.
    - 1. You will die.
    - 2. You can't take it with you.
    - 3. You lose control of your estate.

Ecclesiastes #4

- 4. What you built won't last.
- D. We are meant to work for something greater than ourselves.
  - **1.** A <u>King</u> whose glory is <u>infinite</u> (Isa 49:3; 60:2) —His glory seen in us, greater than ours could ever be
  - **2.** A <u>Kingdom</u> whose nature is <u>eternal</u> (Dan 4:3; 7:14, 27; Lk 1:33; Col 15:58, Rev 14:13).
- III. **ENJOYING LIFE** (24-26)—it is possible
  - A. As Good as It Gets (24)—managing our expectations
    - 1. East of Eden —this world is broken
    - 2. South of Paradise —there is a God in heaven
    - 3. Under (Generous) Providence God still blesses us here and now
  - **B.** The Hand of God (24)—recognizing God's sovereignty
    - 1. God's Choice—submission to the Creator
    - **2.** God's <u>Action</u>—personal involvement
    - 3. God's **Provision** (Mat 6:11)
      - a. Food—basic sustenance, what we need to live
      - b. Enjoyment
        - Capacity to enjoy
        - Things to enjoy
        - Relationship to enjoy
  - C. The Gift of God (26; Mat 5:6, Col 2:3)—He gives what the godless strive for
    - 1. Wisdom (Prov 2:6; Jam 1:5) —from heaven; Holy Scripture, Jesus Christ
    - 2. Knowledge (Pro 1:7; Lk 1:7)—all we need for life and doctrine
    - **3. Joy** (Ps 21:6; Mat 25:21)—joy in His presence; we enter into *His* joy
    - **4. Treasures of This World** (Mat 5:6, Prov 10:22)—gathered by others, given to the blessed
  - **D.** <u>The Pleasure of God</u> (26;; 1 Cor 2:9; Rom 8:28 )
    - **1.** In right <u>relationship</u> with Him—His beloved child; in Jesus, He is pleased with you
    - 2. In gratitude for His gifts— enjoying them, recognizing Him as the source
