Masterful Management Genesis 47:11-26

Godly stewardship promotes:

I. Integrity - "Joseph gathered up all the money" (vs. 11-14)
It is Character --- is to character what health is to the body or 20/20 is to eyesight

Being responsible with the:

- A. Facts "as Pharaoh commanded"
- B. Family "Joseph nourished his father, and his brethren"
- C. Funds "brought to money into Pharaoh's house"
- II. Dignity "Why should we die in thy presence" (vs 15-19)
 It is Compassion It is connected to respect and honor...what we desire and what we afford others.

Being respectful of an individual's:

- A. Pride "we will not hide it from my lord"
- **B.** Power "I will give you for your cattle, if money fail"
- C. Property "buy us and our land...and give us seed"
- III. Creativity "Thou hast saved our lives" (vs. 20-26)
 It is Change -...Innovation....Allowing what God has instilled in us to grow and develop...We are in the image of a creative God.

 Being realistic expecting others to:
 - A. Relinquish "bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh"
 - **B.** Relocate "removed them to cities from one end...to the other"
 - C. Render "Pharaoh should have the fifth part"
