Four Rhetorical Questions

1 Corinthians 9:1 (NASB)

Am I not free? Am I not an apostle? Have I not seen Jesus our Lord? Are you not my work in the Lord?

- The answer to these questions is "Yes"
- Context: Paul will give up rights to protect his brother in Christ (8:13)
- Paul's willingingness to give up rights in order to serve was likely used against him

Paul's Preaching at Corinth Established the Church There

1 Corinthians 9:2 (NASB)

If to others I am not an apostle, at least I am to you; for you are the seal of my apostleship in the Lord.

- Acts 18:1-11 narrates the founding of the church at Corinth
- Seal is sphragis which signifies valid attestation of authenticity

Paul Subordinates Valid Rights

1 Corinthians 9:3-4 (NASB)

My defense to those who examine me is this: Do we not have a right to eat and drink?

- 'Defense' and 'examine' are legal terms: apologia and anakrino
- Some critics evidently saw Paul's nonuse of certain rights as proof of weakness
- The elitists claimed and excercised rights which Paul did not

Marriage Status & Rights

1 Corinthians 9:5 (NASB)

Do we not have a right to take along a believing wife, even as the rest of the apostles and the brothers of the Lord and Cephas?

- This text does not say all apostles were married but that they had a right to be
- The implication is that an accompanying wife would also be supported

- The well-being of the Lord's flock is more important than rights
- The Lord Himself is the supreme example of subordinating His rights for the sake of the heirs of salvation

1 Corinthians 11:1 (NASB)

Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ.

1 Philippians 3:17 (NASB)

Brethren, join in following my example, and observe those who walk according to the pattern you have in us.

Jesus Subordinated Divine Rights

Philippians 2:5-7 (NASB)

Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men.

Jesus Laid Down His Life

Philippians 2:8-9 (NASB)

Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name,

Philippians 2:10-11 (NASB)

so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
