Isaiah 43:7 7 Everyone who is called by My name, Whom I have created for My glory; I have formed him, yes, I have made him.” (NKJV)

Ephesians 1:4-6 4 ... He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, 5 having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, 6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved. (NKJV)

2 Corinthians 4:6 6 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. (NKJV)

2 Corinthians 3:18 18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord. (NKJV)

1 Corinthians 10:31 31 Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. (NKJV)
