Acts 19:1-7

- According to verse 4, what was the intent of the baptism of John the Baptist?
- How many disciples were present?
- What was the purpose of the miraculous sign gifts?

Acts 19:8-10

- What was Paul's approach to sharing the Gospel?
- What were some of the responses to his teaching?
- How do people respond today?
- In what ways do we struggle to respond properly?
- What was the result of Paul's consistent proclamation?
- In what ways can we advance the Gospel in our world today?

Acts 19:18-27

- These verses indicate that there is a spiritual battle that takes place as the Gospel goes forth.
- How did the lives of the believers change after they trusted Christ?
- How did these changes impact the economy in Ephesus?
- What did it cost for these believers to live for the Lord?
- What are some reasons that Christian churches today are ineffective in the culture?
- How might the application of Biblical truth change individual behavior?
- What terms would be appropriate to describe the lives of believers in Ephesus? Do you think those terms apply to the Christian church in America?
