# GALATIANS 4:21-31

5. The use of the Old Testament in analogy or illustration does not establish biblical doctrine (4:24-30)
6. Those who promote the Mosaic Law oppose and persecute the children of promise (4:29)
7. Those who promote the Law have no part in the promise of God (4:30)
8. Those who promote the Law must be removed from the fellowship (4:30)
9. True believers must appreciate their freedom in Christ (4:31)
