Sermon Text: Romans 10:5-13

The Lord bestows His riches through the faith of covenantal grace.

Moses writes about the Covenant of Grace.

1) The Covenant of Grace always upholds the righteousness of the law (10:5).

- a) Personal Obedience
- b) Perfect Obedience
- c) Perpetual Obedience
- d) **Application:**
 - i) High View of the Law
 - ii) Sober View of Self
 - iii) Necessity of Grace

2) The Covenant of Grace always provides the righteousness of faith.

- a) The Righteousness of Christ Accomplished and Vindicated (10:6-7).
- b) Righteousness Received by Faith (10:8-10)
 - i) The Simplicity of Faith (v. 8)
 - ii) Content (v. 9): "Jesus is Lord . . . God raised Him from the dead"
 - iii) Confession (v. 9a, 10b): "with your mouth"
 - iv) Belief (v. 9b, 10a): "in your heart"
- c) One Lord, One Righteousness for All (vv. 11-13)
- d) **Application:**
 - i) Gospel Content: Event and Effect
 - (1) Christ Incarnated: Christ Restored Human Nature
 - (2) Christ Obeyed: Christ Fulfilled All Righteousness
 - (3) Christ Died: Christ Atoned for Sin
 - (4) Christ Arose: Christ Gives Eternal Life
 - (5) Christ Ascended: Christ Restores to God
 - (6) Christ Enthroned: Christ Rules
 - (7) Christ Returns: Christ Makes All Things New
