1. God has made it clear that He does not show \_\_\_\_\_ toward people in relation to the outward circumstances of their life. Thankfully, the gospel is for everyone.

2. It is only through faith in Jesus Christ that any person can have \_\_\_\_\_ with God and be forgiven of their sins.
- God gave the message of the gospel to the world through the sons of \_\_\_\_\_.
  - The gospel focuses on the righteous life, the shameful death, and the victorious resurrection of Jesus of Nazareth—the \_\_\_\_\_ One.
