 - B. The first main point instructs wives regarding husbands that are "disobedient to the word"
 - C. The second main point concerning husbands toward wives includes the phrase "in the same way"
 - D. The chief instruction given here is likely to believing spouses married to unbelieving spouses, with significant application being made to households including two redeemed spouses.
- II. The Wife and Submission (1-6)
 - A. Submission does not mean nor imply "inferiority"
 - B. Submission applies in believing and unbelieving contexts
 - C. How should it look?
 - D. Example: Sarah to Abraham
- III. The Understanding Husband (7)
 - A. Live with her as someone "weaker"

 - C. The man who does not demonstrate honor and worth to his wife does not show real honor or worth to God
