"Worshiping Through The Word!" Nehemiah 8:1-8

Introduction:

- 1. What Is Worship?
 - If You Ask Many Church-Going People Today, You Will Probably Get Many Different Answers!
 - Most Would Probably Say That Worship Has To Do With Music / Bands / An Atmosphere Where You "Feel" Close To God While You Sing!
 - We Will Find A Completely Different Understanding Of Worship In Nehemiah Tonight!
- 2. Remember: Nehemiah Led The People Of Jerusalem & Judah To Complete The Wall In Record Time!
 - But Noone Felt Compelled To Live Inside Those Walls!
 - Called Together An Assembly In Chapter 7, To Convince & Encourage The People To Make Jerusalem Their Home Once Again!
 - And It Worked! Here In Chapter 8, We Find The People Again "Gathered" Together *Inside* The Walls Of Jerusalem!
 - And This Time, They Come Together Not For Work / Not For A Census / But For Worship!
 - And Throughout This Passage, We Find At The Center Of Worship:
 - Not Music / Bands / Singing!
 - But The Word Of God!
- 3. We Need To Remember That God Has Intended For His People To Worship Him Through His Word!
 - Worship Is Not External It Is Internal! It Is A Response In Your Heart To What You Learn About God Through His Word!
 - This Is Why: The Center Of Worship Is The Word!
 - Then & Now! There & Here!
 - Some Very Interesting Parallels To What We Ought To Do In Our Worship Services Today!
- * When We Worship Through The Word, There Will Be:
- 1. An Assembly For God's Word!
 - 8:1-2 "And all the people gathered themselves together as one man into the street that was before the water gate; and they spake unto Ezra the scribe to bring the book of the law of Moses, which the LORD had commanded to Israel. / And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and all that could hear with understanding, upon the first day of the seventh month!"
 - In Chapter 7, The People Learned That Their Ancestors Had Returned From Babylon Around 100 Years Earlier As One People! But Over The Years, They Had Gone Their Own Ways & Started Doing Their Own Things! But Here In Chapter 8, We Find One Thing That Reunited These People Together "As One Man" The Word Of God!
 - This Ought To Be Our "Common Ground" As Well!
 - Unified As One People!
 - "As One Man!" As One Body! Unified In Purpose & Practice! Exactly What The Church Is To Look Like As We Gather Together!
 - Romans 12:4-5 "For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office: / So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another!"
 - Unified Into One Place!
 - "Into The Street That Was Before The Water Gate!"
 - A Plaza Or Square Symbol Of A Place Of Cleansing & Commitment "Where Justice Was Administered & Oaths Were Taken!"
 - Hebrews 10:25 "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together!"
 - Unified For One Purpose!
 - "Bring The Book!"
 - Ezra Ezra 7:6 "A Ready Scribe In The Law!"
 - Ezra & The People Understood That The Center Of Worship Is The Word!
 - Unified With One Priority!
 - "Lord Had Commanded!"
 - They Wanted To Learn / Change / Grow! They Wanted To Hear & Heed! To Obey! Our Priority?

- Unified With One Preparation!
 - "Congregation Both Of Men And Women, And All That Could Hear With Understanding!" (Probably Children)
 - Points To The Fact That Both The Preacher (Ezra) & The People Were Prepared To Worship Through The Word!
 - The Preacher Is Expected To Be Prepared!
 - What About The Hearers? The People?
 - The People Were Prepared As Well!
 - Would Have Taken Great Preparation For This To Bring Their Families From The Outlying Villages & Homes! "Great Pains!" What Have We Gone Through To Prepare For This Day?
 - What Would Happen If The Preacher Didn't Show?
 - Send For Him? Another? Leave?
 - They Needed To Be Prepared, Because The "Seventh Month" Was An Important Month!
 - Feast Of Trumpets / Day Of Atonement / Feast Of Tabernacles! Time Of National & Spiritual Renewal & Revival!
- They Knew That This Renewal Could Only Come Through The Word Of God!
 - So They Assembled Together To Worship Through The Word!
- * When We Worship Through The Word, There Will Be:
- 2. An Attention To God's Word!
 - 8:3-4 "And he read therein before the street that was before the water gate from the morning until midday, before the men and the women, and those that could understand; and the ears of all the people were attentive unto the book of the law. / And Ezra the scribe stood upon a pulpit of wood, which they had made for the purpose; and beside him stood Mattithiah, and Shema, and Anaiah, and Urijah, and Hilkiah, and Maaseiah, on his right hand; and on his left hand, Pedaiah, and Mishael, and Malchiah, and Hashum, and Hashbadana, Zechariah, and Meshullam!"
 - An Example Is Given Here Of Both The Actions & Attitudes Of Worshiping Through The Word!
 - The Word Of God Was The Focus! It Was Read!
 - Read Publically!
 - "Before The Street!"
 - "In Front" Of The People!
 - Read Persistently!
 - "From The Morning Until Midday!"
 - Nearly A 6 Hour Service! From Dawn Till Noon!
 - But The People Were Eager To Hear The Word Of God!
 - Brevity Was Not The Key Clarity Was!
 - Read Passionately!
 - "Ears Of The People Were Attentive!"
 - They Had "Ears To Hear" & Were "Eager To Hear!"
 - Important To Them! Food For Hunger / Water For Thirst!
 - Read Prominently!
 - "Stood Upon A Pulpit Of Wood!"
 - Ezra "Stood" To Show His Reverence For & The Authority Of The Law Of God!
 - "Pulpit" Platform So People Could See & Hear The Preacher!
 - Read Prepared!
 - Principle Of Preparation Seen Already Two-Fold!
 - Preparation Of The Public / People!
 - Preparation Of The Preacher!
 - Ezra Was Ready As Well! Had A Well-Designed Plan To *Proclaim & Explain* The Word Of God!
 - Read Purposefully!
 - "Made For The Purpose!"
 - The Purpose For The Pulpit Was For God's Word To Be Proclaimed & Explained! Nothing Else!

- 13 Other Teachers Were Available Next To Ezra!
 - To Show The People Their Agreement!
 - To Serve The People!
 - To Share With The People What The Lord Was Teaching & Had Taught Them! Prepared Also!
- They Knew The Importance Of Understanding The Word Of God!
 - So They Paid Attention, So They Could Worship Through The Word!
- * When We Worship Through The Word, There Will Be:
- 3. An Admiration For God's Word!
 - 8:5-6 "And Ezra opened the book in the sight of all the people; (for he was above all the people;) and when he opened it, all the people stood up: / And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God. And all the people answered, Amen, with lifting up their hands: and they bowed their heads, and worshipped the LORD with their faces to the ground!"
 - We See That The Word Of God Was Important To Both The Preacher & The People! Central To Worship! Seen In:
 - The Handling Of God's Word!
 - "Opened The Book In The Sight Of All The People!"
 - Ezra Showed How Important God's Word Was To Him When He "Opened The Book!"
 - Not About Him! His Personality / His Opinions / His Delivery / But About His God!
 - When Preachers / Teachers Do Not "Open The Book" They Show What Is Important To Them!
 - The Honoring Of God's Word!
 - "All The People Stood Up!"
 - The People Showed How Important God's Word Was To Them! This Was Natural & Instinctive!
 - Not For An Important Person, But An Important Event The Preaching Of God's Word!
 - IE: Standing At Other Events Concerts / Games! With Anticipation & Excitement! Pacers Game!
 - Do We Admire & Honor God's Word In This Way?
 - After All, *This* Is How God Speaks With Us! *This* Is How We Encounter God! *This* Is How We Even Know Who & How To Worship! *This* Is Why We Are Here! *This* Is To Be The Very First Item Of Business On The Church's Agenda! Acts 2:42 "They Continued Stedfastly In The Apostles Doctrine!"
 - The Hallowing Of God's Word!
 - Responded In Worship To The Word Of God!
 - The Preacher Worshiped: "Blessed The Lord!"
 - The People Worshiped!
 - Through Their Dedication!
 - "Answered: Amen! Amen!"
 - Through Their Devotion!
 - Motions Of Devotion! "Lifting Up Their Hands!"
 - Symbol Of Dependence & Surrender! Emotion!
 - Through Their Dejection! And Humility!
 - "Bowed Their Heads" / "Faces To The Ground!"
 - They Responded To The Word Of God!
 - Through Admiration & Worship Based On The Word Of God!
- * When We Worship Through The Word, There Will Be:
- 4. An Application Of God's Word!
 - 8:7-8 "Also Jeshua, and Bani, and Sherebiah, Jamin, Akkub, Shabbethai, Hodijah, Maaseiah, Kelita, Azariah, Jozabad, Hanan, Pelaiah, and the Levites, caused the people to understand the law: and the people stood in their place. / So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to understand the reading!"
 - Another 13 Men, As Well As The "Levites," Had An Important Role As Well To Make Sure

The People Understood God's Word & Were Able To Apply It To Their Own Lives!

- Order Of Service: Ezra Read / Those On The Platform Explained / Those On The Ground Applied!
- Personal Application!
 - This Group Of Men Were Sufficient In Number To Make Sure Every Person (Man / Woman / Child) Understood! Answer Questions!
- Practical Application!
 - "Caused The People To Understand!"
 - Process: Proclamation / Explanation / Application!
 - What The Word Maintains / Means / Matters!
 - Application Major Emphasis Seen Later In Chapter 8!
- Pervasive Application!
 - All Of The People Remained There Until They Did Understand! Knew That What They Heard Was About Them & For Them!
- Pure Application!
 - 8:8 A Summary Of What Was Done At This Worship Service!
 - The Purpose Was The Purity Of God's Word!
 - The Content Of The Message Was Pure!
 - Ezra Read "Distinctly" Loud & Clear!
 - The Commentary On The Message Was Pure!
 - Expositors "Gave The Sense!"
 - Providing Insight Into The Meaning Of God's Word!
 - The Comprehension Of The Message Was Pure!
 - Levites "Pastors" "Caused Them To Understand The Reading!"
 - Not Just Hearers, But Doers! (James 1:22)
- This Is The Most Important Part Of The Message!
 - Because Only Through Proper, Personal, Practical & Pure Application, Can We Truly Worship Through The Word!

Conclusion:

- 1. The Word Of God Is To Be Central To Our Worship!
 - It Was For Ezra & Nehemiah It Must Be For Us!
- 2. Is It
 - Do We Assemble For God's Word?
 - Do We Pay Attention To God's Word?
 - Do We Admire God's Word?
 - Do We Apply God's Word?
- 3. This Is How We Worship Through The Word!
