8 INTRODUCTION

9 CHRIST, OUR MISSIONARY MESSIAH, CAME TO DO THE WILL OF GOD.

• Luke 4:17-21: 17 And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: 18 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;

10 **LUKE 4:17-21**

• 19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord." 20 Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. 21 And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

11 HEBREWS 10:5-7, 10:

• 5 Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me. 6 In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure. - Jesus Christ Son of God and Son of Mary
- Second person of the holy Trinity
- · Creator of all things.
- The One whose body was prepared for Him at the incarnation a body You have prepared for Me.
- The Obedient Son 'Behold, I have come— In the volume of the book it is written of Me—To do Your will, O God.'"

13 CHRIST, OUR MISSIONARY MESSIAH, CAME TO BECOME OUR SUBSTITUTE

- V. 10: By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.
- This verse tells us that because Jesus perfectly did God's will, we have been sanctified, set apart as God's children.
- This was accomplished through the offering of the body of Christ when He died for our sins on the cross of Calvary.

14 HEBREWS 7:25-27

• 25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. 26 For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens; 27 who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's, for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself.

15 CHRIST OUR MISSIONARY MESSIAH CAME TO SAVE HIS PEOPLE FROM THEIR SINS.

- Matthew 1:21: 21 And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."
- Luke 19:10: 10 for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."
- 1 Timothy 1:15: 15 This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief.
- 1 John 2:2: 2 And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.

16 GETTY'S HYMN "IN CHRIST ALONE"

- Controversy with the Presbyterian Church (USA) hymnal committee
- The committee requested permission from Getty and Stuart Townend to use an alternative lyric to the phrase "Till on that cross as Jesus died/the wrath of God was satisfied", changing "wrath of God was satisfied" to "the love of God was magnified."
- Getty and Townsend rejected this lyric change, and the hymnal committee barred the hymn from the book
