I. WHY DO EXCELLENT WORK?

A. Your judgment before God.

"For God will bring every work into judgment, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil." Ecclesiastes 12:14

"13 each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is.

14 If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward.

15 If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss;..."

I Corinthians 3:13-15a

B. Your testimony before people.

"Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven." Matthew 5:16

II. HOW TO DO EXCELLENT WORK

A. Demonstrate excellent character.

"But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's delicacies, nor with the wine which he drank; therefore he requested of the chief of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself."

Daniel's character was pure.

"that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ," Philippians 1:10

B. Demonstrate excellent skills.

"12 Inasmuch as an excellent spirit, knowledge, understanding, interpreting dreams, solving riddles, and explaining enigmas were found in this Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar, now let Daniel be called, and he will give the interpretation."

13 Then Daniel was brought in before the king. The king spoke, and said to Daniel, "Are you that Daniel who is one of the captives from Judah, whom my father the king brought from Judah?

14 I have heard of you, that the Spirit of God is in you, and that light and understanding and excellent wisdom are found in you." Daniel 5:12-14

Daniel's skills were wise.

"Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy." Psalm 33:3

God highlights in the Bible the importance of doing excellent work (Exodus 28:39; II Chronicles 2:7, 14; 34:12 and Jeremiah 10:9).

C. Demonstrate excellent dedication.
