"Freely Give!" 2 Corinthians 11:5-11

Introduction:

- 1. Let's Head Back In Our Bibles This Morning:
 - To 2 Corinthians 11:
 - Where The Apostle Paul:
 - Has Been Appealing To The Corinthian Church:
 - To Reject The Influence:
 - Of The False Leaders Who Were Leading Them Astray:
 - With A Message About Another Jesus, Another Spirit, And Another Gospel! (11:4)
 - And So In 11:5-11 Paul's Appeal Continues:
 - "For I suppose I was not a whit behind the very chiefest apostles. / But though I be rude in speech, yet not in knowledge; but we have been throughly made manifest among you in all things. / Have I committed an offence in abasing myself that ye might be exalted, because I have preached to you the gospel of God freely? / I robbed other churches, taking wages of them, to do you service. / And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all things I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and so will I keep myself. / As the truth of Christ is in me, no man shall stop me of this boasting in the regions of Achaia. / Wherefore? because I love you not? God knoweth!"
- 2. Now I'm Sure You Are All Familiar With:
 - That Old Adage:
 - "You Get What You Pay For!"
 - A Lot Of Times When You Pay A Bargain Price:
 - You Are Going To Get:
 - Bargain Quality!
 - There Are Probably Times In Your Life:
 - That This Has Proven True For You As Well!
 - Well There Was A Similar Principle At Work:
 - In Ancient Greece:
 - And In Cities Like Athens That Great Center:
 - Of Philosophy As Well As In:
 - The City Of Corinth!
 - Whenever A Young, Up-And-Coming Philosopher:
 - Wanted To Share His Insights With Others:
 - He Would Charge His Pupils For The Privilege Of Hearing His Wit & Wisdom!
 - And This Became A Well-Known Practice By The Time Paul Visited Greece With The Gospel!
 - In Fact The Practice Became So Wide-Spread:
 - That If Someone Did Not Charge:
 - For Their Instruction & Insight:
 - It Wasn't Considered To Be Of Much Value!
 - They Came To Believe That Even When It Comes To Teaching About Wisdom & Virtue:
 - "You Get What You Pay For!"
- 3. Well This Seems To Have Been:
 - Another Accusation Against The Apostle Paul:
 - By The False Apostles That We've Been Learning About!
 - Because As We Just Read In 11:7:
 - Paul "Preached The Gospel Of God Freely!"
 - Without Money & Without Price!
 - And So In That Culture:
 - This Would Have Been One Reason Why:
 - Paul's Message Was Considered Foolish & Without Value!
 - As He Said In:
 - 1 Corinthians 1:18 "For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God!"

- But For Paul:
 - His Pattern Of Ministry:
 - And Sharing The Gospel "Freely" & "Without Charge" Was:
 - A Living Illustration & Example:
 - Of The Gospel Itself!
 - Whenever Paul Would Start Preaching The Gospel:
 - In A New City Like Ephesus & Thessolonica & Corinth:
 - He Would Work With His Own Hands:
 - As A Tent-Maker & Leather-Worker In Order To Provide For Both His Personal & Ministry Needs!
 - And Every Once-In-A-While He Would Also Receive Love-Gifts From Other Churches He Had Already Established!
 - And Even Though Paul Believed That:
 - "The Laborer Is Worthy Of His Hire" And That:
 - Ministers Of The Gospel Have The Right:
 - To Be Paid & Provided For By Those They Minister To:
 - Paul Chose Not To Exercise That Right!
 - So Instead:
- 4. Paul Chose To Live Out:
 - What Jesus Told His Disciples To Do:
 - In Matthew 10:8:
 - "Freely Ye Have Received, Freely Give!"
 - Freely Give!
 - For Paul:
 - This Was The Mark Of A True Apostle!
 - This Was The Mark:
 - Of A True Follower Of Jesus Christ!
 - And So It Remains!
 - "Freely Ye Have Received, Freely Give!"
 - And This Morning I Would Like For You To See:
 - From Paul's Own Life & Ministry:
 - Just What This Means:
 - In Your Own Life & Ministry!
 - True Followers Of Jesus Christ:
 - "Freely Give!"
 - What Christ Himself Has Given:
 - So Freely To Them!
- * First As We See From The Life Of The Apostle Paul We Need To:
- 1. Freely Give God's Truth!
 - Which Is What Paul Gave To The Corinthians:
 - In 11:6 When He Said:
 - "But Though I Be Rude (Unprofessional / Untrained) In Speech Like Those Other Professional Philosophers Yet Not In Knowledge!"
 - For Paul This Was Not A Statement Of Pride!
 - Instead It Was A Statement Of Truth!
 - God Had Graciously Provided Him:
 - Knowledge Of The Truth!
 - Truth That He Did Not Know Before He Met Jesus On The Road To Damascus!
 - And Since He Had "Freely Received" God's Truth:
 - He Was Going To "Freely Give" God's Truth:
 - To Others Who Were In The Same Plight!
 - And As We See In 11:5-6:
 - Paul Gave Out God's Truth:
 - Through Careful Examination!
 - In 11:5 Paul Writes "For I suppose I was not a whit behind the very chiefest apostles!"
 - Now There Is Some Debate As To Who:

- Paul Is Talking About In This Verse!
 - Who Are These "Very Chiefest Apostles" Or "Super-Apostles" As Other Translations May Put It!
- It May Refer To:
 - The False Apostles:
 - And What They Thought Of Themselves!
- Or It May Refer To:
 - The True Apostles:
 - And How They Were Referred To By The Corinthians!
- Either Way The Point Paul Is Making Is That:
 - He Took The Accusations Against Him:
 - Personally & Very Seriously Because He Didn't What There To Be Any Truth:
 - In Their Statements!
- He Already Felt At Times:
 - That He Did Not Deserve To Be:
 - An Apostle Of Jesus Christ!
 - 1 Corinthians 15:9-10 "For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. / But by the grace of God I am what I am!"
- And So After Careful Examination:
 - Paul Could Make The Truthful Claim:
 - That He Was "Not A Whit Behind" Any Of The Apostles In Both His Authenticity As An Apostle & His Authority As An Apostle!
 - He Was A Genuine & True Apostle Of Jesus Christ!
- And So He Also Gave Out God's Truth:
- Through Complete Transparency!
 - 11:6 "But though I be rude in speech, yet not in knowledge; but we have been throughly made manifest among you in all things!"
 - Because Of The Truth:
 - Freely Given To Him By God:
 - Paul Never Wanted To Veer From The Truth:
 - In Any Way, Shape Or Form!
 - Not Only Did Paul *Speak* The Truth:
 - He Sought To *Live Out* The Truth:
 - In Complete Transparency!
 - Acts 24:16 "And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and toward men!"
- If You Are A Christian This Morning:
 - You Too Have Been Given God's Truth!
 - A Truth That Has Made You Free!
 - John 8:32 "And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free!"
 - You Know The Truth:
 - About God:
 - And His Holy & Righteous Nature!
 - You Know The Truth:
 - About Yourself:
 - And How Your Sin Separated You From A Relationship With God!
 - You Know The Truth:
 - About Salvation:
 - That "There Is None Other Name Under Heaven Given Among Men, Whereby We Must Be Saved!" (Acts 4:12)
 - Now How Do You Know These Things / Truths?
 - As Jesus Told Peter "Flesh And Blood Has Not Revealed It Unto You, But The Father Who Is In Haven!"
 - You Only Know These Truths Because God Has Revealed Them To You!
 - Now What Will You Do With His Truth?
 - As Jesus Said "Freely Ye Have Received, Freely Give!"
 - Freely Give God's Truth To Others!

- * Second We Also See That We Need To:
- 2. Freely Give God's Hope!
 - Which Is What Paul Shared With The Corinthians In:
 - The Second Half Of 11:7b When He Wrote:
 - "I Have Preached To You The Gospel Of God!"
 - The Gospel Is The Good News Of Jesus Christ As Your Savior From Sin & Death!
 - This Was The Reason Why Paul:
 - When To The City Of Corinth:
 - In The First Place!
 - And So In The First Part Of 11:7 Paul Asks Them:
 - "Have I Committed An Offense?"
 - Or A Sin Against You?
 - In 11:5 Paul Examined Himself / In 11:7 Paul Wants The Corinthians To Examine Him!
 - Did He Fail Them As An Apostle?
 - Did He Fail Them As Their Spiritual Father?
 - Did He Fail To Lead Them & Teach Them & Love Them:
 - To The Point That They Needed To Look For Another Spiritual Leader?
 - The Answer To Paul's Question:
 - Is Clear!
 - He Had *Not* Failed Them!
 - Instead Since He Had "Freely Received" God's Gospel:
 - He Was Going To "Freely Give" God's Gospel To Them!
 - And As We Read In 11:7
 - Paul Gave Out God's Gospel:
 - With Christ-Like Grace:
 - Because As Paul Asked:
 - "Have I committed an offence in abasing myself that ye might be exalted?"
 - Instead Of Lifting Himself Up:
 - With Pride As The False Leaders Did Expecting & Even Requiring Payment For Services Rendered!
 - Paul Sought To Lift Others Up:
 - By Pointing Them To Christ!
 - And He Was Willing To Pay Any Price:
 - For Them To Receive The Gospel!
 - 12:15 "And I Will Very Gladly Spend And Be Spent For You!"
 - And Isn't This What Jesus Did For Us?
 - Remember Back 8:9 "For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich!"
 - What Humility! What Grace!
 - Paul Also Gave Out God's Gospel:
 - With Christ-Like Generosity!
 - Again 11:7b Paul States:
 - "I have preached to you the gospel of God freely!"
 - As A Gift! As A True Gift!
 - **IE:** Some Gifts Are Not True Gifts! Sone Gifts Are Given With The Understanding That Something Should Be Given In Return!
 - But This Is Not How The Gospel Is To Be Given!
 - The Gospel Is To Be Given:
 - Without Expectation:
 - Of Anything In Return!
 - And Isn't This How Jesus Offered Himself To Us?
 - Romans 3:24 Tells Us That We Are "Justified *freely* by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus!"
 - The Gospel Is The Good News About The Grace & Generosity Of Jesus Christ!
 - If You Are Trusting In This Today:
 - You Too Have Been Given God's Gospel!

- A Gospel That You Have Bought:
 - "Without Money And Without Price!"
 - Though A Price Was Paid Just Not By You "But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot!" (1 Peter 1:19)
- Now What Will You Do With This Gospel?
 - As Jesus Said "Freely Ye Have Received, Freely Give!"
 - Freely Give God's Hope To Others!

* Third - We Need To:

- 3. Freely Give God's Service!
 - Which Is What Paul Offered To The Corinthians In:
 - The Second Half Of 11:8 When He Said:
 - "I robbed other churches, taking wages of them, to do you service!"
 - That Is Ministry For Their Benefit & Their Blessing!
 - And For Paul He Looked At Their Service:
 - As An Opportunity To:
 - Repay A Debt!
 - His Debt To The Lord!
 - 1 Corinthians 9:16 "For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel!"
 - And So When Other Churches:
 - Decided To Offer Paul Some Financial Support:
 - To Help Him Serve The Corinthians:
 - He Was Grateful But He Didn't Want People To Think He Was Taking Advantage Of Or Robbing Those Churches!
 - But Of Course He Wasn't!
 - Because Even Those "Other Churches" Wanted:
 - To Repay Their Own Debt:
 - To The Lord & To Paul!
 - And So They Gave!
 - They Gave Graciously, Generously & Cheerfully!
 - It Was No Robbery To Them!
 - And So Paul Was Freed Up To:
 - Realize A Desire:
 - Of His As He Wrote In 11:9:
 - To Be "Chargeable To No Man" And:
 - To "Keep Himself From Being Burdensome!"
 - Again 11:9 "And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all things I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and so will I keep myself!"
 - Paul's Desire Throughout His Ministry:
 - Was To Not Be A Burden:
 - On The Churches But To Trust In The Lord:
 - For His Provision & Blessing!
 - But Once Again Look At How God Provided:
 - For Paul's Needs!
 - It Was Through The "Other Churches!"
 - Even Through The Poor Churches Of Macedonia:
 - Who Often Gave 8:3 Even Beyond Their Ability!
 - Paul Even Talks About A Time When He Was In Corinth:
 - And "Wanted!"
 - He Came Up Short Financially!
 - He Just Couldn't Make Ends Meet!
 - IE: Corinth Was An Expensive Place To Live! High Cost Of Living!
 - Now Paul Is Not Complaining Here:
 - He Is Merely Explaining That:
 - Even Though This Need:
 - Might Have Gone Unnoticed By:

- That Young & Small Corinthian Church!
- It Did Not Go Unnoticed By:
 - The Lord Who Put It On The Heart Of The Other Churches:
 - To Help Paul!
- What An Example Of Grace & Giving!
 - Those Macedonian Christians!
 - Even Though They Were Still In Poverty:
 - They Wanted To Follow The Grace & Generosity Of Christ!
- And So Paul Remained Free:
 - To "Freely Give" The Gospel:
 - In The City Of Corinth!
- IE: I Still Remember The Time Just Out Of College When I Was Serving At A Church In NW Illinois And I Became Very Sick Needed To See A Doctor But I Had No Money & No Insurance The Pastor Told Be To Make An Appointment With A Christian Doctor In A Nearby Town Which I Did But I Never Saw A Bill! This Doctor Was Known For "Freely Giving" His Services In Order To Keep Others In The Service Of The Lord!
- And When You Are Part Of God's Family:
 - You Too Have Been Given Countless Opportunities:
 - To Serve The Lord & Others:
 - With Your Time, Talents & Gifts!
 - Now What Will You Do With This Service?
 - As Jesus Said "Freely Ye Have Received, Freely Give!"
 - Freely Give God's Service To Others!
- * And Then We Also Need To:
- 4. Freely Give God's Love!
 - Which Paul Alludes To In 11:11 When He Asks:
 - "Wherefore? Because I Love You Not?"
 - Of Course Paul Loved The Corinthian Church!
 - Just Look At How He Served Them!
 - Freely! Faithfully!
 - And So Paul's Love Was:
 - A Dependable Love!
 - 11:10 "As the truth of Christ is in me, no man shall stop me of this boasting in the regions of Achaia!"
 - Paul Wanted The Corinthians To Know:
 - Without Any Doubt:
 - His Love For Them! So He Tells Them:
 - No One Should Question Him:
 - And His Relationship With Them:
 - Because "The Truth Of Christ" Was In Him!
 - Jesus Christ Himself Could Vouch For Paul's Veracity!
 - But Also:
 - No One Will Quiet Him:
 - As He Shares His Love:
 - And Shows His Love:
 - By "Freely Giving" All That He Had "Freely Received!"
 - His Love Was A Dependable Love!
 - But It Was Also:
 - A Deep Love!
 - A Love That God Himself Knew!
 - 11:11 "Wherefore? because I love you not? God knoweth!"
 - Paul Wanted The Corinthians To See That The Primary Motivation Of His Ministry:
 - Was Love!
 - Love For God & Love For Them!
 - And Though They Cannot See Inside Paul's Heart:
 - The Omniscient God Can!
 - Because He Sees All & Knows All & Perceives All!
 - And God Himself Could Vouch For Paul's Love!

Conclusion:

- 1. What Have You "Freely Received" From The Lord:
 - This Morning?
 - As Paul Received:
 - You Too Have Received:
 - God's Truth!
 - And God's Gospel!
 - God's Service!
 - And God's Love!
 - And In Truth:
 - You Have Received So Much More!
 - So Now:
 - What Will You Do:
 - With What You've Been Given?
- 2. Again As Jesus Said In:
 - Matthew 10:8:
 - "Freely Ye Have Received, Freely Give!"
 - IE: Just Last Week My Wife Angie Had The Opportunity To Help A Lady At The Rehab Hospital And This Lady Even Though She Was In That Hospital "To Be Served" Realized That She Too Had The Opportunity "To Serve!" She Gave My Wife These Two Gospel Tracts! As I Told My Wife Later She Was Not Just A Patient She Was A Sister! A Sister In Christ! And As My Wife Looked At Her Bed-Side Table She Had Two Stacks Of These Tracts To Hand Out To Anyone & Everyone Who Might Come Into Her Room! Doctors / Nurses / Aids / Visitors / Passers-By!
 - One Thing I Noticed About These Tracts Is That There Is No Church Information On The Back Like Ours! She Had Purchased These Tracts With Her Own Money! And Why?
 - Because "Freely She Had Received!"
 - God's Truth & Gospel & Service & Love!
 - So She "Freely Gave!"
 - Won't You Do The Same?
