## HOW TO BE RIGHT BEFORE GOD?

I. Count your gains as loss II. Be found in Christ by faith

## I. Learn to count your gains as more than loss

- A. Pre-saved Paul tried to make his case right before God: Gal. 1:14; Phil 3:4-6
  - 1. This mindset is our 'natural default' as in Romans 10:2-3
  - 2. Be open to fact that your thinking about salvation also might be wrong a. some seek salvation by *works* while others by *worths* 
    - b. Satan will do all to use this thinking to hinder you to believe Gospel
  - 3. Within Scripture, none strove more to be worthy or righteous as Paul a. yet no fallen sinner can meet God's standard: Rom. 10:5
    - b. without God, we see not the depth of the law: Rom. 7:7-12
    - c. in Romans 7 Paul shared how God opened his eyes for depth of law
    - 4. Is God teaching you this also?
- B. Paul not learned to shred his 'certificates of good behavior' (vs. 4-7)
  - 1. He learned to count all things more than loss (vs. 8)
    - a. what else must we imagine he gladly gave up?
    - b. why would he call it 'dung'?
  - 2. How far can you come along with Paul in this aspect of his life?

- II. How to be right before God: Be found in Christ by faith
- A. The meaning of 'to be found in Christ by faith' (compare Phil. 2:8)
- B. Why is Paul so exclusively occupied with his desire to be in Jesus Christ?
  - 1. Because Paul failed in every way possible to climb up to God (vs. 9)
    - a. righteousness is what makes a man right in the sight of God
    - b. the 'up-way' or 'down-way' will fail to make us right before God
  - 2. Because God revealed to Paul Who Jesus really was: *Jesus is God's provided righteousness for sinners unable to be righteous*
- C. How then do I come 'to be found in Jesus'?
  - 1. God's answer in Romans 10:6-7 and Phil. 3:9: by faith in Him
    - a. Saving faith is not ascending or descending but submitting (Rom. 10:3)
    - b. Saving faith, a grace worked by the Holy through the Gospel,
      - is not only a certain knowledge of God's gift in Jesus Christ
      - but also trusting in His gift for salvation

**Reflection:** Does this passage expounds your inner spiritual being?

- A. Loathing of all self-righteousness as 'dung' (Phil. 3:8; Ezek. 36:31-32)
- B. Hungering for Christ's righteousness as your only hope (Phil. 3:9 Matt. 5:6)
- C. Reaching forth to live righteousness like Jesus Christ (Phil. 3:13-21)
