Main Point: Leave all judgment to the Lord and walk in unity even though you hold different opinions in disputed matters.

I. Two Different Groups - 14:1-2.

II. Two Related Commands - 14:3.

III. One Risen Judge! - 14:4

Application

- 1) The strong should sometimes defer to the scruples of the weak.

- 2) The weak should be careful to not walk around passing judgment on the basis of disputed matters.

- 3) We should all strive to keep the main thing the main thing! The Great Commission is the main thing!
