MYSTERY REVEALED

Ephesians 3:1-13

- I. <u>MINISTRY OF PAUL</u> (1,2, 7-9)
 - A. Made a Minister of the Gospel (7a; Act 22:14-15)—Jesus appointed him
 - B. Given a Gift of Grace (2)—spiritual gift
 - 1. **By God** (7b)— God made Paul a steward of the gift
 - 2. To Me (8)—the least of all the saints, grace was given
 - a. God's Choice (Act 9:15)—unlikely people to be His saints and ministers
 - b. <u>God's Power</u> (2 Cor 12:9; Col 1:29)—grace to carry out the ministry
 - **3.** For You (2b)—the gift God gave to Paul was not for his own personal benefit but for others (Gentiles)
 - a. You are a <u>steward</u> of the grace given to you.
 - b. The gifts of God are to be employed for the people of God.
 - C. <u>Paul's Particular Mission</u> (Acts 18:4)—apostle to the Gentiles
 - 1. Preach to the Gentiles (8b; Act 22:21)—you're included!
 - **2.** <u>Bring to light for Everyone</u> (9; Act 9:22;18:4; Gal 2:11-14)—the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God
- **II.** MYSTERY OF CHRIST (3-6, 9, 11; Dan 2:21-22, 28, 30, 47)—inclusion of Gentiles and Jews in Christ through the gospel
 - A. Hidden for Ages in God (5, 9, 11)
 - 1. Atonement of Christ always the plan (9b, 11)—before world's foundation
 - 2. Not spelled out for previous generations (5a)—but hinted
 - B. Revealed to apostles and prophets by Holy Spirit (3, 5b; Lk 24:27)
 - 1. Revealed BY the Holy Spirit (Jn 14:26 & 16:13)—divine authority
 - a. The NT Church interpreted everything in light of OT Scriptures. (Act 2:16; 26:22b)
 - b. God will not contradict anything He said previously. (Act 17:11)
 - **2.** Revealed TO the holy apostles and prophets (Eph 2:20; 4:11)—laid the foundation of the Church
 - a. **Apostles**—authority of being primary witnesses of the gospel facts

- b. **Prophets**—living guidance of the Holy Spirit
- c. Paul (Gal 1:11-12, 15-16; Act 26:12-18)—Apostle to the Gentiles
- **C.** Realized in Christ Jesus our Lord (11-12; Gal 4:4-5)—eternal plan brought to fulfillment and revealed in Christ
 - 1. Jesus Christ is the central focus of scripture and human history.
 - 2. Not even Jews previously had free access into the Holy of Holies.
 - 3. In Jesus, Jews and Gentiles alike have free access to the Father.
- **III. PURPOSE OF THE CHURCH** (10)—to display the wisdom and glory of God
 - **A.** <u>The Manifold Wisdom of God</u> (Rev 7:9; 21:24-26)—variegated, many sided, multifaceted, many-splendored
 - **B.** <u>The Witness of the Church</u>—God's ability to reconcile all things in Jesus; church is the place where God's manifold wisdom is displayed
 - C. Spiritual Powers in Heavenly Realm (1 Pet 1:12; 1 Cor 2:7-8)—observe us
- **IV. GLORY IN SUFFERING** (1,13; 2 Tim 2:10;)
 - A. <u>A Prisoner of Christ</u> (Gen 50:20)—in God's providence for good purpose
 - **B.** Suffering for You (Act 9:16; 2 Cor 4:17; Rom 8:17-18; Phil 1:29-30)
 - 1. Voluntary suffering for love and good cause has transcendent meaning.
 - 2. Jesus is the example of suffering to bring good to someone else.
 - C. <u>Being Encouraged</u>—my suffering doesn't mean my efforts have failed
 - D. For Your Glory
 - 1. Shows your status (Gal 6:14)—how much you are loved
 - **2. Will result in your glory** (Rom 8:17-18; 2 Cor 4:15-18)—I am willing to suffer in order to see you brought to final glory.
