II. What is the reason for the book of Ephesians?

- A. The general purpose for all time: *Shock and awe!*
 - 1. an epistle that carries us from eternity to eternity
- B. Paul's intention in writing the epistle
 - 1. no doctrinal error or correction for sin
 - 2. Paul wrote simply (and sweetly) out of love for his friends
 - a. Acts 19:1-20:6 (Paul in Ephesus)
 - b. Acts 20:18-38 (Paul's emotional farewell)
 - c. 2 Cor 2:12-13 (Paul's anxiety over not seeing Titus)

III. Ephesians 6:21-22 – Tychicus

- A. *a beloved brother and faithful minister* Tychicus in the Scripture (Acts 20:4, Col 4:7, 18, 2 Tim 4:12, Tit 3:12)
- B. will make all things known to you the first teacher of this epistle?
- C. to comfort your hearts how the church is in need of such men!
 - 1. Maybe you are a Tychicus? (If not, pray you would be one)
- D. Paul's ecclesiology was not mere theory
- E. Prayer, correspondence and visitation (PVC)
 - 1. Would you commit to using more PVC in 2012?

IV. Ephesians 6:23-24 – The Benediction

- A. Peace to the brothers (shalom, reconciliation)
 - 1. Based upon Christ's *peace* (Eph 2:14)
- B. and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
 - 1. Peace is the basis for loving God and others
 - 2. Love and faith come *from God* demonstrated in election, predestination, adoption, redemption
- C. Grace be with all those who love our Lord
 - 1. Grace as the basis of genuine, lasting love
- D. Incorruptible (immortal, perpetual, undecayingly)
 - 1. Grace as the basis of genuine, lasting love
- E. The unifying nature of this benediction
 - 1. "the brothers" ARE "all those who love Jesus Christ"
