Biblical Giving 2 Corinthians 9:6-15

I. PRINCIPLES: "a cheerful giver" (vv.6-7)

- A. Principle #1: "You reap what you sow" (v.6)
 - 1. Reality Little investment results in little return.
 - 2. Risk Great investment results in great return.
- **B. Principle #2:** "Giving starts in the heart" (v.7)
 - 1. Resolve Predetermine what you want to give.
 - 2. Release Give freely the gift that you predetermined.

II. PROMISES: "God...will supply" (vv.8-11)

- **A. Promise #1:** "God is able" (vv.8-9)
 - 1. Resources God's assets are unlimited (v.8)
 - 2. Recognition God's righteousness is permanent (v.9)
- **B. Promise #2:** "God supplies seed/harvest" (vv.10-11)
 - 1. Reward God's blessings are on the generous (v.10)
 - 2. Results God will increase your harvest (v.11)

III. <u>PRODUCTS</u>: "ministry...service" (vv.12-15)

- A. Needs Met: "Believers are supplied" (v.12a)
- **B. Gratitude Generated:** "God is thanked" (v.12b)
- C. Credit Given: "God will be glorified" (v.13)
- **D. Blessings Requested:** "Believers united" (v.14)
- **E. Favor Bestowed:** "God is recognized" (v.15)
