- I. The Danger Of Loving This Material World (13-21)
 - A. A man calls out for a division of the family inheritance
 - B. The Parable of the Rich Man
 - 1. Notice the subject of the sentence – it is the “land”
 - 2. Notice the worship song the man sings to himself
 - 3. God calls him a fool. Why?
- II. Do Not Worry About Your Life (22-34)
 - A. Eating and clothing
 - B. Your life and body are more than these
 - C. What benefit does worry really give to us?
 - D. Consider God’s care over nature
 - E. Why do we worry about the material things of this life, to the neglect of the spiritual?
 - F. Verse 32 is the key – “Your Father has chosen gladly to give you the kingdom.”
