<sup>12</sup> Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

<sup>13</sup> Thou shalt not kill.

<sup>14</sup> Thou shalt not commit adultery.

<sup>15</sup> Thou shalt not steal.

<sup>16</sup> Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

<sup>17</sup> Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

## **Question # 172: May One Who Doubteth of His Being in Christ, or of His Due Preparation, Come to the Lord's Supper? Answer:**

One who doubteth of his being in Christ, or of his due preparation to the sacrament of the Lord's supper, may have true interest in Christ, though he be not yet assured thereof;<sup>a</sup> and in God's account hath it, if he be duly affected with the apprehension of the want of it,<sup>b</sup> and unfeignedly desires to be found in Christ,<sup>c</sup> and to depart from iniquity:<sup>d</sup> in which case (because promises are made, and this sacrament is appointed, for the relief even of weak and doubting Christians<sup>e</sup>) he is to bewail his unbelief,<sup>f</sup> and labor to have his doubts resolved;<sup>g</sup> and, so doing, he may and ought to come to the Lord's Supper, that he may be further strengthened.<sup>h</sup>
