I. The soul – winning fire.

(Luke 6:26; John 13:16; Jeremiah 20:9; Leviticus 10:1-2; 2 Samuel 6:6-7; 2 Chronicles 26:16-21)

II. The divine call.

(Revelations 22:17; John 1:4-9)

III. Jeremiah wants to quit the ministry.

A) Jeremiah had prophesied that Judah should be carried away captive for their sins.

(Jeremiah 18:15-17; 19:8-9; 20:4-6)

B) Look at what the people had agreed among themselves.

(Jeremiah 18:18)

C) Jeremiah's prophecies about destruction and desolation of Jerusalem aroused a priest.

(Jeremiah 20:2)

IV. The passion for soul – winning is a supernatural endowment from God.

(Jeremiah 1:9; 2 Corinthians 3:6)

V. Natural teaching and preaching of a supernatural word will not do. We need a supernatural element, a miraculous fire in our ministry.
