Some dangers for youth:

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No desire for wisdom or correction – Proverbs 1:2-4, 12:15, 13:1,18, 14:15-16, 15:5,20, 17:25, 26:12

- Legalism Proverbs 22:6, Philippians 3:7-11. Are we training them up to so that they know their only hope, their only life, their only joy is in Christ? Or is behavior medication our main thrust?
- Sexual temptation Proverbs Chs 5-7
- Unwise choices in companions Proverbs 1:15, 13:20, 1 Corinthians 15:33
- Absence of eternal perspective Psalm 39:4-6, 90:10-12, James 4:13-17, 1 Peter 1:24-25, 1 John 2:15-17,
- Lack of heart awareness Deuteronomy 4:9, Proverbs 4:23
