I. Review: *Won't Come—Can't Come—Shall Come—Come unto Me—Hard to Come*

A. Two '*Not Come*' verses

[Joh 5:40](#) And ye will not **come** to me, that ye might have life.

[Joh 6:44](#) No man can **come** to me...

B. One '*Shall Come*' verse

[Joh 6:37](#) All that the Father giveth me shall **come** to me...

C. Two '*Invitation to Come*' verses

[Mat 11:28](#) **Come** unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest

[Rev 22:17](#) ...the Spirit and the bride say, **Come**. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

D. A few '*Hard to Come*' verses

[Luk 9:23](#) ...If any *man* will **come** after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.

[Luk 14:26](#) If any *man* come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple.

[Luk 18:22](#) ...Yet lackest thou one thing: sell all that thou hast, and distribute unto the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and **come**, follow me.

II. One more '*Come*'—Our King is coming back

A. "*There Is Coming a Day...*"

Joh 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will **come** again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, *there* ye may be also.

B. “What a Day—Glorious Day—That Will Be”

2Th 1:10 When he shall **come** to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe...

C. Our King is coming in the clouds

Rev 1:7 Behold, he **cometh** with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they *also* which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him...

Act 1:9 And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.

Act 1:10 And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel;

Act 1:11 Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so **come** in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.

D. Our King is coming—Are you looking?

Tit 2:13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

Tit 2:14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Php 3:20 For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:

Php 3:21 Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.

III. Two ‘Comes’: 1) The King ‘Comes’ 2) To say, “Come”

Mat 25:31 When the Son of man shall **come** in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:

Mat 25:32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth *his* sheep from the goats:

Mat 25:33 And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.

Mat 25:34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, **Come**, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

A. When the King said, “Come”—The dead came

Joh 11:43 And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, **come** forth.

Joh 11:44 And he that was dead came forth...

B. When the King comes to say, “Come”—The dead will come

Joh 5:28 ...the hour is **coming**, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,

Joh 5:29 And shall **come** forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

IV. Details about the wonder of the coming of the King

1Th 4:13 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.

1Th 4:14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

1Th 4:15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive *and* remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

1Th 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

1Th 4:17 Then we which are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

1Co 15:49 And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.

1Co 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

1Co 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

1Co 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1Co 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.

1Co 15:54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

V. When the King comes—The end comes—And the kingdom goes to its eternal realm

1Co 15:23 But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his **coming**.

1Co 15:24 Then *cometh* the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

1Co 15:25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.

1Co 15:26 The last enemy *that* shall be destroyed *is* death.

1Co 15:27 For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under *him*, *it is* manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.

1Co 15:28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that God may be all in all.

VI. The certainty of the King's success—When He comes—All that are His shall come

Joh 6:37 All that the Father giveth me shall **come** to me; and him that **cometh** to me I will in no wise cast out.

Joh 6:38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

Joh 6:39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

Heb 2:13 ...Behold I and the children which God hath given me.

Joh 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

Joh 10:28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand.

Joh 10:29 My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand.

Rom 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

Rom 8:31 What shall we then say to these things? If God *be* for us, who *can be* against us?

Rom 8:32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

Rom 8:33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? *It is* God that justifieth.

Rom 8:34 Who *is* he that condemneth? *It is* Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

Rom 8:38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come,

Rom 8:39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Php 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform *it* until the day of Jesus Christ:

1Th 5:23 ...and *I pray God* your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1Th 5:24 Faithful *is* he that calleth you, who also will do *it*.

VII. Jesus said He is coming—And we say—Come on

Rev 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

*And Lord haste the day when our faith shall be sight,
The clouds be rolled back as a scroll
The trump shall resound, and the Lord shall descend,
Even so, It is well with my soul."*

*When Christ shall come with shout of acclamation;
And take me home, what joy shall fill my heart.*

*Then I shall bow in humble adoration
And there proclaim, My God, How great Thou art.*
