"THE HEART OF THE MATTER" The Preservation of God's Beloved People Deuteronomy 27: 9 - 26 November 15, 2020

"you have become the people of the LORD your God." (Deuteronomy 27: 9)

To fully understand God's preservation of His people highlights our need for the forgiveness of our intrinsic depravity.

- 1. Most of evangelical life simply does not acknowledge the depths to which human depravity has fallen. (*The Problem*) v. 9-12. [Romans 1:28-32]
- 2. God doesn't just show us the letter of the Law but also the heart of the Law and shows us just how fallen we are. (*The Correction*) v. 14
 - a. God shows us that our fallen nature stems from a rebellious heart. (Secret Sins)
 - At root, we hold ourselves to be god [v. 15]
 - Because we see ourselves as god, we expect others to worship us. [v.16]
 - We expect others to give us what we want [v.17]
 - We believe we have the right to do unto others what seems best to us [v18]
 - We believe that others are of less value and dignity [v. 19] [Titus 3:1-7]
 - b. God shows us that our fallen heart will display itself in selfish indulgence. (Sexual Sins)
 - We believe that the authority of the family has no value [v.20]
 - We believe the authority of the created order has no value [v. 21]
 - We believe the responsibility of protecting family has no value[v. 22]
 - We believe the bonds of covenant marriage has no value [v.23]
 - c. God shows us that selfish indulgence will lead us to destroy everything we see. (*Subversive Sins*) [I Corinthians 6:9-11; I Corinthians 6:18-20]
 - We have a complete disregard for those who we are connected to by common confession [v.24]
 - We have a complete disregard for those who we should be defending

- We have a complete disregard for God Himself [v.26]
- 3. We MUST agree with God on just how sinful we really are. (The Follow Through)
