CONFESSION OF FAITH

LOR STOCKING DRIVE FAQs

1. You do not have to purchase everything on your list. Buy whatever you feel comfortable with!
2. Please do not wrap the presents.
3. Don't get stressed out about the sizes. If you end up buying a size bigger/smaller or it gets confusing (different stores have different sizing methods) don't worry about it! We will get the sizes into the right hands.
4. NO toys, puzzles or games. If you would like to add a "little extra" to your gift, you can bring: stuffed animals, books, school supplies, backpacks, pajamas, socks, water bottles, small soft blankets, diapers & wipes or journals.

NOTE: LOR does NOT have children on site. LOR packs up Care Kits for children who are referred to us from schools, local agencies/organizations, churches, and group homes. We pack up 2-weeks-worth of necessities so the children have what they need during their transition. Your gifts will be part of the larger Care Kit given to children throughout the year.
