



“The Resurrection”

Part 5 – By Design
I Corinthians 15:35-44

Resurrection explained by the:

I. Seed – “that which thou soweth” (vs. 35-38)

The seed is:

- A. **Interred** – “that which thou sow is not quickened, except it die”
- B. **Inferior** – “thou sow not that body that shall be, but bare grain”
- C. **Indued** – “God gives it a body as it pleased Him, to every seed”

II. Skin - “All flesh is not the same flesh” (vs. 39-41)

The skin can be:

- A. **Contrasted** – “one kind of flesh of men, another flesh of beasts”
- B. **Celestial** – “there are also celestial bodies”
- C. **Compared** – “one glory of the sun, and another...the moon”

III. Spiritual – “There is a spiritual body” (vs. 42-44)

The spiritual is:

- A. **Superior** - “it(the resurrection) is raised in incorruption”
- B. **Sumptuous** – “sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory”
- C. **Supernatural** – “sown a natural body...raised a spiritual body”
