## UNITY IN THE BODY

Ephesians 4:1-6

**I. EXHORTATION** (1)—live out the implications of the gospel in community of the church

## A. <u>A Prisoner for the Lord</u> (1 Cor 10:31; Col 3:17, 23)

- 1. Christians should expect persecution. (Lk 9:20-23; 2 Tim 3:12;
  - a. To Be Like Our Lord (Mat 10:24-25; Heb 13:13)
  - **b.** As Part of Our Witness (1 Pet 3:14-17)—ready to answer
  - c. As a Great Honor (Act 5:42; Phil 1:29; 2 Thes 1:4-5; )—like prophets
  - d. For Great Rewarded. (Mat 5:11-12)—in heaven

2. Christians should do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus.

(Phil 4:11-13; Col 3:17, 23)-for His glory and kingdom

- a. Recognizing God's Sovereignty (1 Thes 5:16, 18)
- b. Trusting in God's Plan (Gen 50:19-20; Jer 29:11)
- c. As a Sacrifice of Love (Rom 12:1; 2 Tim 4:6; 1 Pet 2:19)

## B. Urging rather than Commanding

- 1. Prefers to appeal and inspire
- 2. Models the behavior he is commending
- C. Live up to Your Calling (Eph 2:1-2, 10)—act like it
  - 1. <u>The Calling</u> to be His holy people; God's initiative, prior action
  - 2. <u>Walking the Walk</u> (Ps 1; Eph 2:1-2, 10)— Respond, living it out. Own it.

**3.** <u>A Worthy Manner</u>—fitting, proper, appropriate to your new identity and the glorious position to which you are called

**II.** <u>MAINTAINING UNITY AND PEACE</u> (2-3)—created by Holy Spirit, now walk in it and live it out

- A. <u>Be Eager to</u>: (3)—sense of urgency; get on it now!
  - 1. <u>Maintain Unity</u>—continuing, intentional work of upkeep
  - 2. <u>Keep the Peace</u> (Ps 34:14)—both internal and external

**a.** <u>**Be peaceable yourself**</u>—not quarrelsome, meddling, easily offended, divisiveness etc...

**b.** <u>Pursue peace with others</u>—guard, maintain, pursue things that promote peace (not peace at any cost)

B. <u>The Necessary Virtues</u> (2)—peace cannot survive without these graces

**1.** <u>Humility</u> (Mat 11:29 & 20:28; Jn 13:12-16; Act 20:19; Phil 2:8; Jam 4:6/1 Pet 5:5)—lowliness, opposite of pride

**2.** <u>Gentleness</u> (Mat 11:29; 21:5/Zec 9:9; 2 Cor 10:1; Gal 5:23; 1 Tim 6:11; 1 Pet 3:4)—meekness; considerate, deliberate self-control of power.

**3.** <u>Patience</u> (Mat 18:23-25; 1 Cor 13:4; Gal 5:22; 1 Thes 5:14; 2 Pet 3:9)— bearing with the weaknesses and foibles of others

**4.** <u>Love</u> (Jn 15:12-13; 1 Cor 13; Eph 3:17; Col 3:14; 1 Jn 4:8)—the motive, the virtue behind the other virtues

## **III. <u>THE BASIS OF OUR UNITY</u> (4-6)—unifying realities of the faith**

A. <u>One Body</u> (Eph 1:22-23; 2:15-16)—Christ's Body, the Church

- B. One Spirit (Jn 3:5-8, Rom 8:15-16; Eph 2:18; )—The Holy Spirit
- C. <u>One Hope</u>—hope in Jesus for what He promises in the gospel, eternal life
- D. <u>One Lord</u> (Rom 10:9; 1 Cor 12:3)—Jesus Christ, Head over church

**E.** <u>**One Faith**</u> (1 Cor 16:13; 2 Tim 4:7; Jude 1:3; )—the Christian Faith; the objective, essential body of Apostolic doctrine

**F.** <u>**One Baptism**</u> (Mat 3:11; Mk 10:38; Act 2:38; Rom 6:3-4; )—baptism into Christ; our spiritual union with Christ, set apart for Him as holy

G. <u>One God</u> (Deut 6:4)—monotheism was basic tenant of Jewish faith

**1.** <u>Father Of</u> All (Eph 3:14)—all the elect, those in Christ; position of authority in family; source of shared identity

2. Over All (Rom 9:5)—God's Authority; Master and Judge

**3.** <u>Through</u> All (Mk 9:38-40)—working through all His people and all circumstances

**4.** <u>In</u> **All** (1 Cor 3:16; Mat 18:20; Ps 14:5)—God's Spirit dwells in all of His chosen and redeemed—individually and corporately as the Church
