- IV. What Each Letter Seeks To Do
 - A. Call the church into order by the voice of a teacher
 - B. That teacher should call their attention to the exalted Christ
 - C. The gospel message of Jesus, either to encourage wisdom or exhort foolishness, should be declared (including a call of faithfulness and repentance)
 - D. A call to leading by the gracious gift of the Spirit
 - E. A promise of present transformation and future fulfillment is made, to the one overcoming their own sin in this present age by the power of the gospel
