What does the Bible teach about the Spirit?

Scripture Reading

JOHN 14:15–17 JOHN 15:26–27 JOHN 16:6–14

The Spirit . . .

- 1. is a person.
- 2. "proceeds from the Father."
- 3. promotes Jesus.
- 4. produced the Scriptures.
- 5. "will be in" Jesus's followers.

 He "turns the light on" in people's hearts about Jesus (aka. *illumination*).
He gives life to dead sinners who hear Jesus's gospel (aka. *regeneration*).
He guarantees believers' inheritance in

Jesus's kingdom (aka. sealing).

- 4. He immerses believers into Jesus's work for them (aka. *baptism*).
- He seeks to control believers' lives with Jesus's authority (aka. *filling*).
 He leads believers to kill sin in their own lives (aka. *mortification*).

- He produces Christlikeness in believers' character (aka. *fruit*).
- 8. He comforts suffering believers with Jesus-like confidence (aka. *witness*).
- He gives Christians service abilities to build Jesus's church (aka. *gifting*).

 He gives Christians courage to tell others about Jesus (aka. *boldness*).
He leads the church to long for Jesus's return (aka. *enflaming*). "You do not go to the theater to stare at the spotlight...but to watch the performance that the spotlight illuminates."
