**Sermon Text: Exodus 4:1-17**

**Moses’ Three Objections**

**1) What if...? (vs. 1)**

- This series of questions from Moses are bad theology. God’s response in vs. 9 shows that God already knows the result.
- Changing “What if...?” to “Even if...” is the language of trusting God

**2) I can’t... (vs. 10)**

- What God calls us for, he will equip us to do – for he promises, “I will be with you” (vs. 12 – echoed in Math 28:20).

**3) I won’t. (vs. 13)**

- This demonstrates a fundamental unwillingness to obey.
- The single greatest sacrifice that God wants from us is obedience.
