THE WICKED

Their deeds:

- 1. Plotteth against the just (12)
- 2. Gnasheth upon him with his teeth (12)
- 3. Cast down the poor and needy (14)
- 4. Slay such as be of upright conversation (14)
- 5. Borroweth, and payeth not again (21)
- 6. Watcheth the righteous, and seeketh to slay him (32)

Their end:

- 1. They shall soon be cut down (2, 9, 10, 15, 20, 22, 28, 36, 38)
- 2. Shall not be, you'll consider his place but not find it (10)
- 3. The Lord shall laugh at him, for he seeth that his day is coming (13)
- 4. The arms of the wicked shall be broken (17)
- 5. The wicked shall perish (20), shall be as the fat of lambs
- 6. Seed of the wicked shall be cut off (28)
- 7. Transgressors shall be destroyed, the wicked cut off (38)

THE UPRIGHT

Their temptation to:

- 1. Fret because of evil doers (1)
- 2. Envy workers of iniquity (1)
- 3. Fret regarding those who prosper in the way and succeed in wickedness (7)
- 4. Fretting, they may contemplate doing evil (8)

Their experience:

- 1. A little is better than the riches of the wicked (16)
- 2. The Lord knoweth the days of the upright (18)
- 3. Shows mercy, and gives (21, 26)
- 4. His life is ordered by the Lord (23)
- 5. The Lord upholds him (24-26)
- 6. The mouth of the righteous speaketh wisdom, the law of God is in his heart

(30-33)

7. Everlasting inheritance (3, 9, 11, 18,22, 29, 33)

God's instruction to them:

- 1. Fret not (1)
- 2. Neither be thou envious (1)
- 3. Trust in the Lord, and do good (3)
- 4. Delight thyself in the Lord (4)
- 5. Commit thy way unto the Lord (5)
- 7. Rest in the Lord (7) (i.e., wait patiently, and fret not
- 8. Cease from anger (8)

- 9. Depart from evil, and do good (27)
- 10. Wait on the Lord (34)
- 11. Mark the perfect man, and behold the upright (37)
