

Message Title: Considering God's Schedule Pt-7

Theme: This message begins looking at the 4th age of the Earth which was during the time that Noah was in the Arc.

The story of Noah and the flood is one of the salient ones in the Bible but it has taken on a lighthearted atmosphere in the way that it focuses on the unusual storyline and the animals instead of God's sovereignty over His creation.

God gave mankind a freewill to expose their heart's desires and separate those who grieve Him from those who desire to please Him. The result was that by the time of Noah the whole earth had become so corrupt that God gave up on them and decided to start over again with Noah's family and animals chosen by God to replenish the Earth.

The most important lesson in the story of the flood is that God hates and judges sin in ways that we can't possibly understand.

Some believe that the account in second Peter 3:5-6 is a description of Noah's flood but that won't fit for the following reasons.

1. The wording in second Peter, "being overflowed with water perished" clearly indicates being rendered useless, which would have required re-creation of all life, (perish is to die, to be destroyed, to come to nothing). Everything that needed to start over had survived and nothing needed to be created.

2. The wording in Genesis 1:2, "And the earth was without form" matches the wording in second Peter, not Noah's flood, ("without form" is lacking a definite shape or shapeless. The mountains that were covered with water in the flood defined a definite shape and "void" is to be completely empty. Only the air breathing creatures that were not on the Arc with Noah and his family perished in the flood).

3. God told Noah and his sons the same thing He told Adam and Eve; "Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth" (see Gen.1:28 and 9:1).

The word replenish is to fill up again, refill, restock and replace. The earth was full of beings before Adam just as it had been before Noah.

Salient Points: Ordained of God, These last days, God's biggest secret, Times and seasons, Ups and downs, Outside supernatural influence, Desire vs duress, An abomination, Beyond saving, When the good influence is gone, Noah and God, All aboard, Mind games, The first rain, Gopher wood, Sealed by God, The flood, UFO sighting, Scoffing Noah, Wormwood, Deceived by peace, God's doings, Still looking.

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The speaker would like you to know that all of these messages are in the chronological progression that God revealed them, and even though many may stand alone, they progress through several subjects that build on the previous lessons. This series of messages titled "Our Timeless Creator" (OTC), shift the focus from salvation and service, to understanding God. How He who needs nothing, benefits from creating the human race. It started in 2007 when God brought the speaker to Psalm 50:15 three times following the miraculous healing of his dying wife. It reads, *“And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me”*. Following this he prayed fervently. "LORD, show me how to glorify you and I will do the best I can". The speaker had become a new creature, (2 Corinthians 5:17) on May 20 1973. At that moment the reality of GOD's existence and the direct connection to the Bible became miraculously clear. Overwhelmed with excitement he began telling everyone who had a few moments to listen, what he had found, like a man who had found a cure for a terminal illness, which everyone had. His excitement and enthusiasm continued for well over a year, even when many said, "you'll get over it." Slowly his efforts began to focus on responsibility and all the how-tos of service. As the excitement faded it was replaced with frustration. He had said many times "the most frustrating thing in life is, knowing what GOD could do and watch him not do it". In 2005 GOD began a work as described in Job 5:17-18, that changed everything. He says," it was much like when I first became a child of God all over again". He describes it like application of (2 Corinthians 3:18), "But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from

glory to glory, *even* as by the Spirit of the Lord”. Truly a life changing experience as God increases and we automatically decrease.
