Journey Through Acts "God Is Faithful" Acts 18:1-23

Introduction:

- 1. Please Turn Back In Your Bibles With Me:
 - To Acts 18 Tonight:

- As We Continue In Our:

- Journey Through Acts - On Sunday Nights!

- Acts 18 - Where The Apostle Paul Continues His Journey:

- To Some 50 Miles Away From The City Of Athens!

- And He Arrives In:

- What Will Become A Well-Known City:

- And Center For Christianity:

- The City Of Corinth!

- 18:1 - "After these things Paul departed from Athens, and came to Corinth!"

2. Here Is A Map Of The Southern Part Of Greece:

- Known As The Peloponnesus:

- Where Other Famous City-States Of Ancient Greece:

- Were Located - Such As:

- Sparta!

- But Corinth Stood:

- As The Gate-Keeper Into This Part Of Greece:

- And Was Separated From Athens & The Rest Of Greece:

- By A Relatively Thin Isthmus!

- 3. But It Was On The Far Western Side:
 - Of The Isthmus Pictured Here:
 - Where Both The Ancient & Modern Cities:
 - Of Corinth Are Located!
 - It Was Between:

- Two Major Ports:

- In The Cities Lechaion & Cenchrea!

- And - Many Times - In Order To Cut The Distance And Time To Travel Around Southern Greece By Ship:

- They Would Transport The Cargo, And Sometimes Even The Ship Itself, Between The Two Ports By Land!

- During The Reign Of Nero:

- He Attempted To Dig A Canal - Where The White Line Is:

- But Never Finished It!

- However - The Canal Was Finished In 1893 - And This Is What It Looks Like Today!

4. But - After The Apostle Paul:

- Would Have Crossed The Isthmus Of Corinth:

- Traveling On The Lechaion Highway:

- He Would Have Arrived In Corinth:

- To This View!

- It Was A Cosmopolitan City:

- With Modern Streets & Modern Shops:

- All Under The Shadow Of A Mighty Mountain:

- Known As The Acro-Corinth:
 - Or The Acropolis Of Corinth!
- 5. Now The City Of Corinth In That Day:
 - Was Not Unlike Our Own Prominent Cities Today!
 - Corinth Was A Very Powerful City!
 - Because It Was One Of The Most Strategically Located Cities In The Ancient World!

- Corinth Was A Very Prosperous City!

- Because It Was Just A Few Miles From Those Two Major Ports! There Was A Lot Of Money To Be Had!
- Corinth Was A Very Prominent City!

- The Acro-Corinth Was One Of The Most Amazing Things About The City! Standing 1,886 Feet High - You Could See It From Miles Around!

- Corinth Was A Very Proud City!

- Just 200 Years Before Paul Went To Corinth To Preach The Gospel – The City Rebelled Against Rome - And The Entire City Was Completely Destroyed & Left In Ruins:

- For 100 Years!

- But After 100 Years, The City Was Completely Rebuilt By Rome – And Became One Of Rome's Most Successful Colonies!

6. And So - It Was Into This Kind Of City:

- That Paul - According To 18:2-3:

- "Found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; (because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:) and came unto them. / And because he was of the same craft, he abode with them, and wrought: for by their occupation they were tentmakers!"

- They Might Have Had A Shop In The Agora / Marketplace Of The City - Pictured Here:

- Or - They Might Have Set Up A Tent To Sell Their Wares On The Outskirts Of The City!

- But - In The Providence Of God - He Provided Paul With Some Friends -Who, Though They Were Not Yet Believers, Would Become So Through Their Connection With Paul!

7. But - While Paul Was In Corinth:

- He Continued His Pattern Of Ministry:

In 18:4 - "And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks!"
Now - Even Though Corinth Is One Of The Most Well-Preserved Sites:

- Of Biblical Antiquity - The Location Of This Synagogue Has Not Been Determined!

- However - Along One Of The Streets - An Ancient Lintel To A Door Was

Found - That Was Inscribed In Greek:

- "Synagogue Of The Hebrews!"

- Here Is What That Stone Lintel Looks Like Today!

- But - You Can Make Out:

- The Last 3 Letters Of "Synagogue" As Well As:

- The First 3 Letters Of "Hebrew!"

- Did The Apostle Paul Pass Under This Lintel On His Way Into The Synagogue To "Persuade The Jews & The Greeks" Who Met There?

- It's Ouite Possible!

8. And While Paul Was In Corinth:

- Eventually, There Was Some Success For The Gospel!

- Which We Read In 18:5-8 - "And when Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the spirit, and testified to the Jews that Jesus was Christ. / And when they opposed themselves, and blasphemed, he shook his raiment, and said unto them, Your blood be upon your own heads; I am clean: from henceforth I will go unto the Gentiles. / And he departed thence, and entered into a certain man's house, named Justus, one that worshipped God, whose house joined hard to the synagogue. / And Crispus, the chief ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing believed, and were baptized!"

- But Along With This Success - There Was Some Trouble On The Horizon For Paul As Well There In Corinth!

9. And So - The Lord Sought To Encourage Paul:

- In 18:9-11 - "Then spake the Lord to Paul in the night by a vision, Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not thy peace: / 10 For I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city. / 11 And he continued there a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them!"

- So - There - In The Shadow Of:

- One Of The Most Pagan Temples Of Ancient History:

- Paul Continued To Preach The Gospel For A Year & A Half!

- You See The City Of Corinth:
 - Was Not Nearly As Refined As The Community Of Athens:
 - Its Closest Neighbor!
 - In Fact Corinth Became Known All Over The World For A Few Things!

- Corinth Was Known For Its Mixture!

- It Too Was A "Melting Pot" – With Different Kinds:

- Of People, Fortunes, Trades & Religions!

- Corinth Was Known For Its Morality!

- Or Rather Its Lack Of Morality!
- Because Of The Great Mixture Of People:
 - What Happened In Corinth Could Stay In Corinth!

- It Became Known As The Roman City Of Vice - A City Of Sin!

- In Their Temple To The Goddess Aphrodite, Wicked Acts Of Immorality Would Take Place:

- Even In Worship!

- Corinth Was Known For Its Materialism!

- When Someone Would Say: "To Live As A Corinthian" It Meant That You Were Living In Luxury And Immorality!
 - And The Romans Made It The Finest City In Greece, And Some 5 Times As Large As Athens, When Paul Arrived!
- It Was Known As A Truly Modern City!
 - But It Was To This City Of Corinth:
 - That God Called The Apostle Paul:
 - And A Church Was Born Through The Preaching Of The Gospel Of Jesus Christ!

- 10.
- But Then The Storm Came In All Its Fury!
 - Picking Up In 18:12-17:

- "And when Gallio was the deputy of Achaia, the Jews made insurrection with one accord against Paul, and brought him to the judgment seat, / 13 Saying, This fellow persuadeth men to worship God contrary to the law. / 14 And when Paul was now about to open his mouth, Gallio said unto the Jews, If it were a matter of wrong or wicked lewdness, O ye Jews, reason would that I should bear with you: / 15 But if it be a question of words and names, and of your law, look ye to it; for I will be no judge of such matters. / 16 And he drave them from the judgment seat. / 17 Then all the Greeks took Sosthenes, the chief ruler of the synagogue, and beat him before the judgment seat. And Gallio cared for none of those things!"

- Here Is A Picture Of The "Judgment Seat" - Or - The "Bema":

- A Stone Platform On Which Gallio:
 - Would Have Sat In Order To Render Judgments For The People!
 - And The Partial Column Standing In The Fore-Ground Is About Where The Apostle Paul Would Have Stood!
 - But God Once Again Proved His Grace And Faithfulness:
 - To Paul & The Other Believers:
 - And Spared Him!
- 11. And So It Was Time For Paul:
 - And His Missionary Companions To Move On:

- Once Again!

- And On Their Way Out They Probably Would Have Placed Their Feet On The Very Pavement:
 - That Had The Name Of A Very Wealthy Man Inscribed On It!

- A Man Named "Erastus!"

- This Is Noteworthy:
 - Because Later In Paul's Letter To The Romans:
 - Which He Wrote From The City Of Corinth:
 - He Sends Greeting In Romans 16:23 From A Man Named "Erastus the chamberlain of the city saluteth you!"
- So There Was Fruit Even Among The Officials:
 - Of That Great City Of Corinth!

12. And With That:

- Paul Heads To The Port City Of Cenchrea:

- In Order To Work His Way:
 - First To Ephesus And Then:

- To Caesarea, Jerusalem, And Back Home:

- To The Church In Antioch!

- And Thus Ends:
 - The Second Missionary Journey:

- And The Beginning Of The Third!

- Which We Read About:
 - In 18:18-23 "And Paul after this tarried there yet a good while, and then took his leave of the brethren,

and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn his head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow. / 19 And he came to Ephesus, and left them there: but he himself entered into the synagogue, and reasoned with the Jews. / 20 When they desired him to tarry longer time with them, he consented not; / 21 But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus. / 22 And when he had landed at Caesarea, and gone up, and saluted the church, he went down to Antioch. / 23 And after he had spent some time there, he departed, and went over all the country of Galatia and Phrygia in order, strengthening all the disciples!"

- Here Is A Map:

- That Shows How Paul Eventually Got Back:

- To Antioch - Which Covers A Lot Of Miles:

- And Probably A Lot Of Time:

- Which Is Condensed Into These 6 Verses!

12. But - Before We Move On From Corinth:

- I Want To Draw Your Attention:

- Back To 18:9-10 - Where - Even As The Church Started Growing In House Of Justus:

- One Night - Paul Was Restless - And Was Trying To Get Some Sleep!

- Even Though There Was Some Visible Success:

- It Is Clear That There Was Something Still Troubling Paul!

- Were There Other:

- Doubts & Discouragements Plaguing Paul's Heart & Mind?

- We're Not Sure What Paul Was Thinking Or Feeling Or Praying That Night:

- But We Do Read Again:

- 18:9-10 - "Then spake the Lord to Paul in the night by a vision, Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not thy peace: /

For I am with thee, and no man shall set on thee to hurt thee: for I have much people in this city!"

- Now - If Paul Was Encouraged & Inspired:

- When Silas & Timothy Finally Came To See Him In Corinth:

- How Much More Encouragement & Inspiration Would Have Filled His Heart:

- When Jesus Himself Visited Him In This Vision!

- And The Lord Had Some Special Words:

- Of Encouragement For Paul!

- Just When He Needed Them The Most!

- And Doesn't The Lord Do This For Us As Well?

- And So - We - Along With Paul:

- Can Take Comfort In:

1. The Presence Of The Lord!

- The Lord Knew That Paul Was Afraid:

- And So - He Says - 18:10 - "I Am With Thee!"

- Now - I Don't Think This Was Anything New To Paul - But It Was A Fresh Comfort &

Encouragement From The Lord!

- And This Truth Belongs To All Believers!

- Remember?

- Isaiah 41:10 - "Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness!"

- Matthew 28:20 - "Lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world!"

- No Matter What You Face As A Christian:

- You Can Persevere Because The Lord Himself Is With You!

- And Will Never Leave You!

- He Is Faithful!

- Also - Comfort In:

2. The Protection Of The Lord!

- At Times - Paul Was In Physical Danger:

- And It Was No Different Here In Corinth - But The Lord Was Not Through With Paul!

- And So - He Says - "And no man shall set on thee to hurt thee!"

- Now - We May Not Be Promised Temporal Protection:

- But We Do Have Eternal Protection!

- And So - Nothing Should Prevent Us From Serving & Speaking For The Lord!

- Romans 8:31 - "What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?"

- No Matter What You Face As A Christian:

- "We Are Immortal Until Our Work On Earth Is Done!" (George Whitefield)
 - Are You Alive? God Is Not Through With You Yet! Also Comfort In:

3. The Promise Of The Lord!

- God Had A Reason For Paul To Be There In Corinth!

- 18:10 "For I have much people in this city!"
 - The Lord Knew This & Could Say This Because In That Profligate City He Had Personally & Graciously Chosen Some To Become A Part Of His Family!
- Matthew Henry "Yet In That Heap, That Seemed To Be All Chaff, There Was Wheat! Yet In That Ore, That Seemed To Be All Dross, There Was Gold!"
 - And So Paul Was Given The Encouragement:
 - That There Were "Fish In That Sea!"
 - And This Prospect & Hope Would Help Motivate & Encourage Him To Keep Fishing For Men! For Souls!
- And This Promise:
 - Of God's Own Electing Grace:
 - Is A Comfort & And An Encouragement:
 - To Us As We Seek To Live & Serve & Witness For The Lord Right Where We Are!
 - In Our Church! In Our Community! In Our Families!
- We May Not Know Them Yet!
 - They Themselves May Not Know It Yet!
 - But 2 Timothy 2:19 "The Lord knoweth them that are his!"
 - "Paul Knew Them Not, But Jesus Did!" (Hawker)

Conclusion:

- So Like Paul You And I Do Not Need To:
 - "Be Not Weary In Well Doing" Because:
 - We Can Have Confidence In The Faithfulness Of The Lord!
 - His Faithful Presence!
 - His Faithful Protection!
 - His Faithful Promises!
 - And Even / Especially His Faithful Possession!
 - You See Paul Was Also In That City:
 - And He Could Rest Assured That "By Grace Through Faith" He Belonged To The Lord!
- 2. And So With These Fresh Encouragements:
- 18:11 "And he continued there a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them!"
 - His Heart Was Encouraged:
 - And So He Stayed In Corinth!
- 3. It Is Easy For Us To Get Discouraged:
 - In Our Lives & Walk With The Lord!
 - But The Next Time You Are:
 - Remember The Faithfulness Of God!
