The Righteousness of God

I. It is Jesus' righteousness II. It is the believer's righteousness

I. The Righteousness of God is Jesus' righteousness

- A. Paul never tired in unfolding God's plan of salvation in Gospel of Jesus
 - 1. in Ch. 1-3:20 he has unpacked the bad news (vs. 19-20, 23)
 - 2. in Ch. 3:21-8:39 Paul unpacks the *good news*: (vs. 22, 24)
- B. The 'righteousness of God' does not refer to God's attribute but God's Gospel
 - 1. It is Jesus' work He did when the Word became flesh and lived & died
 - 2. Yet it is called God's righteousness because our Lord Jesus is God

II. It is (becomes) the believer's righteousness

- A. Though this righteousness is 'unto all' it is not 'upon all'
 - 1. How often God's servants proclaimed: *Unto you, O men, I call?* (Prov. 8:4)
 - 2. Yet we are not to make the offer of grace same as grace received
- B. This righteousness is upon all of them that believe
 - 1. What hinders us commonly from receiving this righteousness?
 - 2. What does God declare to all believers in vs. 22?

Final Reflection: Do this in remembrance of Me.

A. The gift of vs. 22 to us meant a 'gift' of God to Jesus Christ
