## "The Goal Of Spiritual Growth!" 1 Peter 2:1-3

## Introduction:

- 1. **IE:** We Have Probably All Heard The Old Adage: "If You Aim At Nothing, You Will Hit It Every Time!"
  - This Is Why It Is Important To Have Something To Aim At!
    - A Goal! In Every Part Of Your Life!
  - Goals Are Important! And One Goal In Particular Is Very Common!
    - What Does A Farmer & A Parent Have In Common? They Have The Same Goal!
  - What Is The Primary Goal For A Farmer?
    - The Goal For A Farmer Is Growth!
      - Why Else Would He Spend So Much Time, Energy & Money Planting Seeds Into The Ground?
  - What Is The Primary Goal For A Parent?
    - The Goal For A Parent Is Growth!
      - So That Their Children Can Become Godly & Productive Citizens!
  - The Goal These 2 Groups Have In Common Is: Growth!
    - No Farmer Wants His Crops To Remain A Seed!
    - No Parent Wants His Child To Remain A Baby!
      - Growth Is One Of The Most Exciting Things About Being A Parent!
    - And If There Is No Growth:
      - It Is A Sign That There Are Some Major Problems!
- 2. It Is No Different For Us In Our Christian Life!
  - We Need A Goal!
    - And Peter Tells Us What This Goal Is In 2:1-3!
      - Read Passage!
  - The Goal For A Christian Is Growth!
    - This Should Be Our Goal Because This Is God's Goal!
    - And God Knows What You & I Need To Grow!
    - IE: A Parent Knows What A Child Needs In Order To Grow! Last Night, Many Children Celebrated Halloween By "Trick Or Treating" Their Goal Get As Much Candy As They Can! And Then, Eat As Much As They Can! A Parent Knows Better! Knows What A Child Needs For Growth! Provides What A Child Needs For Growth! Not Just Candy!
  - God Knows & Has Provided What You Need In Order To Grow!
    - 2 Peter 1:3 He Has: "Given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness!"
  - What Does A Christian Need To Grow? Peter Points Out:
    - The Spirit Of God!
      - 1:1; 1:12; 1:22!
    - The Word Of God! This Is His Focus Here!
      - 1:23; 2:2 "The sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby!"
- 3. A Christian Can Only Grow In Connection With The Word Of God!
  - Described As: "The Sincere Milk Of The Word!"
    - Or The "Pure Spiritual Milk" Or "Pure Milk Of The Soul!"
    - This Is What We Need To Grow!
      - Because It Is Clear! And Understandable!
      - Because It Is Clean! And Pure / Unadulterated!
      - Because It Is Critical! "The Divinely Given Nourishment Supplied By The Gospel!" (Selwyn)
  - The Goal For A Christian Should Be Growth!
    - And This Growth Can Only Be Found In Connection With The Word Of God!
- 4. Are You Growing?
  - Is There An Ongoing Development & Maturity As A Christian?
    - Tell In Your Treatment Of The Word Of God!
- \* In Order To Grow:
- 1. There Must Be An Application Of The Word Of God! Is There?
  - You Will Never Grow As A Christian, If You Are Not Applying To Your Own Life What You Have

Already Heard From God's Word!

- 2:1 "Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings!"
  - This Is Application Plain & Simple!
- What Kind Of Application Is Necessary To Grow?
- An Application That Is Primary!
  - "Wherefore!" "Therefore!"
  - After Hearing What Has Just Been Communicated & Commanded Application Will Be The Normal & Natural Response Of A Christian!
  - Primary Desire: To Hear / Obey / Apply God's Word!
  - He Just Got Through Giving Them 3 Specific Commands!
    - Live A Life Of Holiness! (1:13)
    - Live A Life Of Fear! (1:17)
    - Life A Life Of Love! (1:22)
  - Now, Your Primary Responsibility Is To Apply / Obey What You Have Heard To Your Life! Have You?
    - "If You Don't Apply What You Already Know You Will Never Be Able To Continue To Grow!"
- An Application That Is Personal!
  - Peter Then Lists 5 Things That Are "Relationship Killers!"
  - Remember What The Last Command Was In Chapter 1?
    - 1:22 "See That Ye Love One Another With A Pure Heart Fervently!"
  - If You Practice The Things In 2:1, Then You Are Not Obeying This Command! These Are The Opposite Of Love!
    - And You Cannot / Will Not Grow!
    - Because You Have Not Started Applying To Your Life What God Has Already Told You!
- An Application That Is Practical! Application Is Very Practical!
  - How Do You Know If You Are Applying The Command To Love?
  - You Are: "Laying Aside" These Sinful Practices!
    - To "Put Off" / "Cast Off" A Piece Of Clothing!
    - Breaking Away From These Sins:
      - Definitely / Decisively / Dramatically!
  - Cast Away Your Sinful Attitude!
    - "All Malice" A Feeling Of Ill-Will Toward Another Christian! Not Wanting What Is Best!
  - Cast Away Your Sinful Advantage!
    - "All Guile" Manipulation & Deception To Use People For Your Own Advantage & Personal Gain!
  - Cast Away Your Sinful Acting!
    - "Hypocrisies" Living A Lie Not Being / Saying / Acting As You Really Are Two Faced!
      - 1:22 Our Love Is To Be "Unfeigned!"
  - Cast Away Your Sinful Animosity!
    - "Envies" "Feeling Of Discontentment & Resentment" Toward Other Christians & What They Have!
  - Cast Away Your Sinful Address!
    - "All Evil Speakings!" Things Spoken To Tear Down & Not Build Up We Are To Edify! Not "Edifry!"
    - Ephesians 4:29 "Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers!"
- If You Are Not Growing It Is Because There Is No Application Of God's Word In Your Life! Is Your Goal As A Christian To Grow?
  - In Order To Grow, You Must Apply What You Know!

2. There Must Be An Appetite For The Word Of God! Is There?

<sup>\*</sup> In Order To Grow:

- Growth Will Only Come Through God's Word!
  - 2:2 "As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby!"
  - To Grow: You Need An Appetite For God's Word!
    - What Kind Of Appetite?
- An Appetite From Poverty!
  - "As Newborn Babes!"
  - You Need To See Your Need For God's Word, Before You Will Be Hungry For It!
    - Otherwise, You Will Remain Content Without It!
  - As A "Newborn Babe"
    - You Cannot Feed Yourself! You Must Be Fed!
    - You Don't Know What You Need! It Must Be Given To You!
  - If You Are Full & Satisfied With Everything Else This World Offers You Will Not Be Hungry For God's Word!
- An Appetite Of Passion!
  - "Desire!"
    - To Long For! With Fervency & Passion!
    - IE: Like A Baby "Desiring" Its Milk! He Lets You Know It! And Won't Stop Until He's Full!
  - We Need To "Hunger & Thirst" For God's Word This Way!
    - Don't Settle For Anything Else! Nothing Else Will Truly Satisfy & Strengthen!
  - What Is This Like?
    - Psalm 119:97 "O how love I thy law! it is my meditation all the day!"
- An Appetite For Purity!
  - "Desire The Sincere Milk Of The Word!"
    - Or The Pure Milk Of The Soul! The Only Thing That Will Help You Grow!
    - "This Milk Is Nothing But The Gospel!" (Selwyn)
  - We Are To Move On In Our "Taste" For Meat!
    - Hebrews 5:14 "But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil!"
  - But We Must Never Get Over Our Desire For The Milk!
    - The Fundamental / Foundational Truths Of The Gospel! ("Jesus Loves Me This I Know!")
- An Appetite With Purpose!
  - "That Ye May Grow Thereby!"
    - The Goal Of A Christian Is To Grow!
  - You Will Only Grow / Develop / Mature When You Have This Kind Of Appetite For The Word Of God!
    - And Then Apply Its Commands & Principles To Your Life!
  - You Will Only Grow Through The Message & The Ministry Of The Word Of God!
    - Reading / Studying / Teaching / Preaching!
  - If You Are Not Growing It Is Because You Have No Appetite For The Word Of God!
- Is Your Goal As A Christian To Grow?
  - Then You Must Have This Kind Of Appetite For God's Word! "Desire The Sincere Milk Of The Word!"

## \* In Order To Grow:

- 3. There Must Be An Acceptance Of The Word Of God! Is There?
  - Peter Now Reminds Us That This Application & Appetite Will Only Be In The Life Of Genuine Christians!
    - 2:3 "If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious!"
    - You May Have No Spiritual Growth:
      - Because You Have No Spiritual Life!
    - This Is Where It Starts!
      - You Can't Expect A Flower Without A Seed!
      - You Can't Expect Growth Without Life!
    - To Grow: You Must First Have Accepted The Message Of The Word Of God The Gospel!
  - Have You Accepted The Ground Of The Gospel?

- "If So Be"
- You Will Only Apply God's Word & Have An Appetite For God's Word When You Have Accepted The Gospel Message!
  - You Are A Sinner & Deserve Death!
  - Jesus Is A Savior & Offers Life!
  - "Nothing In My Hand I Bring, Simply To Thy Cross I Cling!" (Augustus Toplady)
- Have You Accepted The Goal Of The Gospel?
  - "Ye Have Tasted!"
    - To Personally Experience The Truth Of The Gospel Message! Not Someone Else's Experience: Not Your Pastor's / Parent's / Brother's / Sister's / Friend's! Your Own! Have You Tasted?
  - Luther "It Is Said To Be Tasted When I Believe With My Heart That Christ Gave Himself For Me, And Has Become My Own, And My Sin And Misery Are His, And His Life Also Is Mine!"
    - Uses The Sense Of Taste!
      - Only Sense To Take The Object Inside!
    - You Can Hear / See / Feel / Smell Object Stays Outside! But When You Taste You Bring The Object Into Yourself & It Becomes A Part Of You!
  - This Is God's Goal For The Gospel!
    - For You To Personally Accept Jesus Christ As Your Lord & Savior! This Is Where Growth Starts!
      - There Is No Spiritual Growth Without Spiritual Life!
- Have You Accepted The Goodness Of The Gospel?
  - "That The Lord Is Gracious!"
    - Reminding Us Of Psalm 34:8 "O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him!"
  - There Is Nothing As Sweet & Strengthening As The Lord!
  - Psalm 36:7 "How excellent is thy lovingkindness, O God!"
  - Zechariah 9:17 "For how great is his goodness, and how great is his beauty!"
- If You Are Not Growing It May Be Because You Have Never Personally Accepted & Received The Message Of God's Word!
  - The Gospel Of His Son, Jesus Christ!
  - This Is Where It Must Begin!
    - There Is No Spiritual Growth Without Spiritual Life!

## Conclusion:

- 1. Do You Have Spiritual Growth As Your Goal?
  - If You Are A Christian You Should!
  - If You Do:
    - Remember: It Will Only Come Through The Word Of God "The Pure Milk Of The Soul!"
- 2. How Can You Grow?
  - There Must Be An Application Of God's Word!
  - There Must Be An Appetite For God's Word!
  - There Must Be An Acceptance Of God's Word!
- 3. Now, Are You Prepared To Grow?
  - 2 Peter 3:18 "But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen!"
  - Growth Is To Be The Goal Of A Christian!
