Why NORTHLAND REFORMED CHURCH? "NORTHLAND"

This is really just a geographic locator. We are located in the "Northland" area of the Kansas City Metro.

"REFORMED"

We are called REFORMED because we are CREEDAL. This means we plainly and clearly tell what we believe the Bible teaches. We believe what faithful Christians have always believed. These beliefs are not secret or private, but clearly stated and openly taught.

They proclaim the living faith of historic Christianity. They include the **Apostles and Nicene Creeds** of the early Church, and the creedal statements known as the **Three Forms of Unity** (consisting of the **Heidelberg Catechism**, the **Belgic Confession** and the **Canons of Dort**). These three statements were formulated by leaders of the PROTESTANT REFORMATION between 1560 and 1619 and have been adopted by faithful churches ever since as the standard or measure of "**the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints**" (Jude 3).

We believe the Scriptures are complete and authoritative. We do not believe any other writings or revelations can challenge the **Truth** of what has been written and preserved in God's Word, the Holy Bible. The Scriptures are the **ONLY** divinely inspired infallible and inerrant Word of God! (see Revelation 22:18,19).

"CHURCH"

Throughout the history of the world, Christ has been gathering a people for himself. Using His Spirit and Word, He defends and protects His people unto the end. Nothing can separate them from His love. Christ is the only head of the Church. The Church is composed of Christian believers, whose lives have been transformed by the power of the Gospel. They come from all countries, races, and classes. As Revelation 5 says, "**You have redeemed us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us kings and priests to our God**".

OUR HERITAGE

Northland Reformed Church is a member congregation of the Reformed Church in the United States (founded in 1748). Our history goes back to the Protestant Reformation of the sixteenth-century. The Reformers summarized the teachings of Scripture in several historic confessions that came to be known as **The Three Forms of Unity**: the **Heidelberg Catechism** (1563), the **Belgic Confession** (1561) and the **Canons of Dort** (1619). Along with the **Apostles, Nicene and Athanasian Creeds** (of the early church) we embrace them as our own. We believe they accurately summarize the teachings of God's unchanging word, the Holy Bible.

OUR AUTHORITY

With the church throughout history we believe that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the **only divinely inspired, infallible Word of God**. They are the final authority for all questions of doctrine and life. The Spirit of God creates faith in our hearts through the preaching of the Gospel. The Lord Jesus is the only Head of the Church and has appointed pastors, elders and deacons to oversee His people. As officers they affirm and vow to uphold our church confessions, make joint decisions and be accountable to their fellow officers in the Classis and Synod of the Reformed Church in the U.S.

OUR FAITH IN CHRIST

"**There is no other name under heaven given among men, by whom we must be saved**" (*Acts 4:12*). Jesus Christ is the only eternal Son of God and His life of perfect obedience and willing self-sacrifice for our sins is the basis of our salvation. To those who believe, He grants forgiveness of sins, true righteousness, and eternal life. These gifts, which we can neither earn nor deserve, are freely given to those who by true faith are engrafted into Him. In response to this salvation, we will be grateful and strive to live uprightly before Him. As we grow in grace, we will more and more love God, His Word and His Ways, and at the same time come to hate sin and flee from it. We trust in the grace of God to preserve us in this faith to the end. We believe that the Lord Jesus now possesses all authority in heaven and earth (Mt. 28:18) and will, on the appointed day, return to judge the living and the dead.
