

1. Question 4: Who is Jesus Christ and what did He accomplish?
2. First - He is the only mediator of the covenant of grace between God and mankind.
3. A mediator is one who intervenes between two persons who are at variance - with a view to bring about reconciliation. (Job 9:33; 1 Timothy 2:5; 2 Corinthians 5:19; Romans 5:10)
4. Jesus Christ is the mediator of the covenant of grace (the New Covenant). (Hebrews 8:6 and 9:11-17)
5. Jesus Christ is Prophet, Priest, and King. (Acts 3:22; Hebrews 4:14, 7:11-8:1)
6. God became flesh and dwelled among man. This is called the "Incarnation." (Galatians 4:4, John 1:14; Hebrews 2:14, 17)
7. Mary of Nazareth - a young virgin (Jewish woman) - conceived the child through the Holy Spirit so that her child was not only holy but He was the Son of God. (Luke 1:31-35)
8. Jesus grew tired and slept. Jesus experienced hunger and emotion - and at the same time nature itself obeyed His commands. (Colossians 2:9)
9. No other world religion can offer such a mediator or savior as Christianity.
10. The public ministry of Jesus Christ began at the approximate age of 30. He healed the sick, cast out demons, performed miracles - and called on men to follow Him. (Acts 2:22, 10:38; Matthew 16:24)
11. Jesus Christ rose from the dead as the living Savior. Christ rose bodily from the grave - the tomb was left empty. (Luke 24:1-48)
12. Jesus Christ ascended to the right hand of the Father. (Acts 1:9-11 and Ephesians 1:20-21)
13. When we consider the love of the Father in sending His Son, and the love of the Son in coming to do the will of the Father, we should be overwhelmed at the goodness of God.
14. Jesus Christ is indeed worthy of all of our praise, adoration, obedience, and love.
15. Revelation 1:4-8
