

Husbands

- o "according to knowledge" (cf. 2:19; 3:2 "in fear"; 2 Pet. 1:2-3, 5, 8; 2:20; 3:18)
- o A weaker "vessel?" (Gr. skeuei | cf. 1 Thess. 4:3-5; 2 Cor. 4:7-11)
- o Honor, not (just) sympathy
 - An effective prayer life is at stake (cf. 1 Pet. 4:7)

Men and Women, Husbands and Wives

- Male headship—an objective position (Eph. 5:23)
 Not based on leadership skill, theological acumen
 - Not based on leadersnip skill, theological acumen or intellectual giftedness, but on God's design patterned after redemption (Isa. 54:4-5; Eph. 5:22-33) and exemplified in the Trinity
- God's plan is not for wives to place their trust in their husbands; it is for wives to place their trust in Him as they reflect the glory of the purified church under Christ (Eph. 5:26-27).
 - Wives: Posture vs. Picture

Men and Women, Husbands and Wives Submission in the fear of God will prohibit wives from submitting to their husbands on occasions where they are being led to explicitly sin or violate their conscience (Rom. 14:23).  o Wives: Divinely appointed "house-despots" (1 Tim. 5:14;
 Prov. 31:11; Titus 2:5)
- Summary: Wives are to act in accordance with their husbands' leading and direction, while expecting to have authority and influence of their own in the home as their husband's leadership takes a biblical shape, and as they glorify God together by self-sacrificially playing their respective roles with excellence.
