*Heart Attitudes for a New Year*

## 1) Clothe Your Heart with \_\_\_\_\_ (v.12-14)

if we love one another, God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us. » *1 John 4:12*

And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also. » *1 John 4:21*

## 2) Let Peace \_\_\_\_\_ Your Heart (v.15)

<sup>13</sup> But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. <sup>14</sup> For He Himself is our peace, who made both groups into one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall » *Ephesians 2:13-14*

<sup>6</sup> Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. » *Philippians 4:6-7*

### 3) Have a \_\_\_\_\_ Heart (v.15)

always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ  
to God, even the Father » *Ephesians 5:20*

in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus » *1 Thessalonians 5:18*

### 4) Get the Word \_\_\_\_\_ Your Heart (v.16)

(God) will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you » *Romans 8:11*

I have treasured the words of His mouth more than my necessary food » *Job 23:12*

<sup>10</sup> With all my heart I have sought You... <sup>11</sup> Your word I have treasured in my heart...  
» *Psalm 119:10-11*

*“The Word in the heart and mind is the handle by which the Spirit turns the will.”*

### 5) \_\_\_\_\_ Out Christ's Heart (v.17)

Whether, then, you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. » *1 Corinthians 10:31*

In all your ways acknowledge Him... » *Proverbs 3:6*

<sup>15</sup> For we are a fragrance of Christ to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing; <sup>16</sup> to the one an aroma from death to death, to the other an aroma from life to life.  
And who is adequate for these things? » *2 Corinthians 2:15-16*
