1. What part of the sermon was especially meaningful to you?
2. What does God's judgment over sin indicate about His character? Does this cause you to shudder in fear or stand amazed at His grace?
3. What is the significance of Genesis 3:15? How does this verse help to explain the story line of the entire Bible?
4. What is the significance of the curse placed upon the woman (3:16)? Consider the curse in light of (2:18) and (3:30). How has this particular curse impacted your life or marriage?
5. What is the significance of the curse placed upon the man (3:17-19)? Consider the curse in light of (1:29-31) and (2:15). How has this particular curse impacted your life or marriage?
6. How does God respond to Adam and Eve's sin (3:21)? What does this demonstrate about God's character (see Psalm 103:8-14)?
7. What is the greatest fear or concern that you are facing? How does the gospel and Christ's return give you hope to overcome those fears (Rev. 21:1-4)?
8. What does it mean to live in light of Christ's return? How might this group help you set your heart on the city to come?
