

## **1689 London Baptist Confession Chapter III Of God's Decree**

- I. God hath decreed...all things whatsoever comes to pass  
in Himself  
from all eternity  
by the most wise and holy counsel of His own will  
freely  
and unchangeably
- II. yet to as thereby is God  
neither the author of sin  
nor hath fellowship with any therein  
nor is violence offered to the will of the creature  
nor yet is the liberty, or contingency, of second causes  
taken away but rather established.
- III. in which appears  
his wisdom in disposing of things  
and power,  
and faithfulness in accomplishing his decree.
