Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

Community Group Discussion: In Philip 3:8 Paul says that there is something of surpassing value to all other things. It is knowing Christ Jesus His Lord. He then continues to elaborate on what it is to know Christ mentioning (among other things) both the power of His resurrection and attaining to the resurrection from the dead. Knowing Christ requires experiencing Him and the power of His resurrection and attaining to the resurrection from the dead. If we do not know the power of Christ's resurrection and if we do not finally attain to the resurrection from the dead, we do not know Christ as Paul sought to know Him and as God intends us to know Him. What is it to know the power of Christ's resurrection (10)? What is it to attain to the resurrection of the dead (11)? Further, note that these things of surpassing value are Paul's goal, no mere interesting sidebar. Knowing Jesus in this way was the center of Paul's life focus. It was what he pressed for (12,14) and what he calls us to press for following his example (15,17). Are you so pressing? How? And how should we so press? These are heavenly things and not the stuff we think about naturally. Why then should we think of them and not the more accessible earthly things (17-21)?
