For the glory of His grace God governs history according to His plan of salvation in His Son.

1) God has always governed history with a goal of salvation in His Son.

- a) Creation—Adam a type of the One to come
- b) Covenant of Grace/Seed of Serpent vs. Seed of Woman; Cain/Seth lineage
- c) Covenant of Grace with Noah/Pre-flood Corruption/Cleansing
- d) Covenant of Grace with Patriarchs Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob
- e) Covenant of Grace with Israel—Mosaic Covenant a tutor to guard and guide to Christ
 - i) Commandments—the message of holiness
 - ii) Priesthood—the message of a Mediator
 - iii) Circumcision—the message of regeneration
 - iv) Sacrifices—the message of atonement
 - v) Purity—the message of cleansing
- f) Covenant of Grace with David—the message of the Kingdom
- g) Covenant of Grace for Exiles—the message of New Covenant
 - i) Daniel—the Kingdom of God/saints to dominate all kingdoms
 - ii) Prophets—the fulness of Covenant of Grace in Messiah

h) Application:

- i) Same Covenant of Grace—substance is Christ
- ii) Different Administration—less clarity; less Gentile inclusion

2) God continues to govern history under the salvation in His Son.

- a) Christ and New Creation
- b) Christ crushes the serpent's head
- c) Christ brings the comfort and peace longed for with Noah
- d) Christ blesses all families of the earth
- e) Christ fulfills the righteousness of the law; satisfies the penalty of the law; cleanses from sin's defilement
- f) Christ rules the nations
- g) Application:
 - i) Types and shadows now fulfilled—no longer practiced
 - ii) We are empowered by Christ to disciple the nations
