3 free will defense

- ① limited knowledge defense Deut. 29:29; Job
- © negation/privation defense Gen. 1; Col. 1:16; 1 Tim. 4:4
- God wills evil to exist without Himself being evil
 - the black of evil amplifies the brilliance of God's glory Rom. 3:5; 9:22-23
 - the black of evil amplifies the wonder of God's holiness and mercy Jude 4; Rom. 5:8-9
