### Look to the Lord

*1 Pet 5:7 – casting all your anxieties on the Lord, because He cares for you...*

*Phil 4:6 – do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God...*

1) Historical Setting – 2 Kings 18:3-16 (1 Sam 15:22; Deut 5:32-33, 6:24-25, 7:9-21; Jer 17:5-8, Deut 8:2-3)

2) Calling to Trust – 31:1-5

3) Calling to Repent – 31:6=32:8

4) Calling Away from False-Peace – 32:9-20
