WIN LIKE A WAR-HORSE!

TEXT: Song 1:7 Tell me, O thou whom my soul loveth, where thou feedest, where thou makest thy flock to rest at noon: for why should I be as one that turneth aside by the flocks of thy companions?

8 If thou know not, O thou fairest among women, go thy way forth by the footsteps of the flock, and feed thy kids beside the shepherds' tents.

9 I have compared thee, O my love, to a company of horses in Pharaoh's chariots.

10 Thy cheeks are comely with rows of jewels, thy neck with chains of gold.

11 We will make thee borders of gold with studs of silver.

Proverbs 21:31 The horse is prepared against the day of battle: but safety is of the LORD.

Psalms 20:7 Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the LORD our God.

Zechariah 10:3...for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.

1 Kings 10:28 And Solomon had horses brought out of Egypt, and linen yarn...

29 And a chariot came up and went out of Egypt for six hundred shekels of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty...

Isaiah 31:1 Woe to them that go down to Egypt for help; and stay on horses, and trust in chariots, because they are many; and in horsemen, because they are very strong...

3 Now the Egyptians are men, and not God; and their horses flesh, and not spirit...

Psalms 33:17 An horse is a vain thing for safety: neither shall he deliver any by his great strength...

10 Thy cheeks are comely with rows of jewels, thy neck with chains of gold.

11 We will make thee borders of gold with studs of silver.

Judges 8:26...beside ornaments, and collars, and purple raiment that was on the kings of Midian, and beside the chains that were about their camels' necks.

Ezekiel 16:30 How weak is thine heart, saith the Lord GOD, seeing thou doest all these things, the work of an imperious whorish woman;

Job 39:21 He paweth in the valley, and rejoiceth in his strength...
24...neither believeth he that it is the sound of the trumpet.

Genesis 24:17 And the servant ran to meet her, and said, Let me, I pray thee, drink a little water of thy pitcher.

18 And she said, Drink, my lord: and she hasted, and let down her pitcher upon her hand, and gave him drink.

19 And when she had done giving him drink, she said, I will draw water for thy camels also, until they have done drinking.

20 And she hasted, and emptied her pitcher into the trough, and ran again unto the well to draw water, and drew for all his camels.

21 And the man **wondering at her** held his peace...

1 Chronicles 16:29...worship the LORD in the **beauty of holiness**.

1 Peter 3:4 But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, **even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price**.

5 For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

Jeremiah 8:6...every one turned to his course, as **the horse rusheth into the battle**.

Jeremiah 46:9 Come up, ye horses; and rage, ye chariots...

Job 39:19 Hast thou given the horse **strength?** hast thou clothed his neck with thunder?

20 Canst thou make him afraid as a grasshopper? the glory of his nostrils is **terrible**.

21 He paweth in the valley, and **rejoiceth in his strength: he goeth on** to meet the armed men.

22 He mocketh at fear, and **is not affrighted**; neither turneth he back from the sword.

23 The quiver rattleth against him, the glittering spear and the shield.

24 He swalloweth the ground with fierceness and rage: neither believeth he that it is the sound of the trumpet.

25 He saith among the trumpets, Ha, ha; and he smelleth the battle afar off, the thunder of the captains, and the shouting.

2 Timothy 2:1 Thou therefore, my son, **be strong** in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 6:10 Finally, my brethren, **be strong in the Lord**, and in the power of his might.

1 Corinthians 16:13 Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, **be strong**.

1 Peter 3:14 But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye: and **be not afraid of their terror**, neither be troubled;

1 Corinthians 6:12...I will not be brought under the power of any.

Philippians 1:27 Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye **stand fast in one spirit,** with **one mind striving together** for the faith of the gospel;

28 And **in nothing terrified by your adversaries:** which is to them an evident token of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that of God.

Job 39:20 Canst thou make him afraid as a grasshopper? the glory of his nostrils is **terrible.**

Romans 6:16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; **whether of sin** unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

Isaiah 41:10 Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

Song of Solomon 6:10 Who is she that looketh forth as the morning, fair as the moon, clear as the sun, and **terrible as an army with banners?**

Proverbs 28:1 The wicked flee when no man pursueth: but **the righteous are bold as a lion.**

Song of Solomon 6:4 Thou art **beautiful**, O my love, as Tirzah, comely as Jerusalem, **terrible as an army with banners.**

5 Turn away thine eyes from me, for they have overcome me: thy hair is as a flock of goats that appear from Gilead.

Genesis 32:28 And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for **as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed.**

Hosea 12:3 He took his brother by the heel in the womb, and by his strength he had power with God:

4 Yea, he had power over the angel, and prevailed...

Isaiah 45:11 Thus saith the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands **command ye me.**

Luke 12:37 Blessed are those servants, whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.
